THE VICTIMS OF DEIR EZZOR IN SIX MONTHS .. DETAILS WITH FIGURES OBTAINED BY DEIR EZZOR 24 NETWORK

Exclusive: Hundreds of people have been killed in Deir Ezzor province during the first half of 2019 and Deir Ezzor 24 Network has been able to document most of the civilians of the province who have been killed by the different forces located in Deir Ezzor and outside.

Deir Ezzor 24 network has documented the killing of 390 civilians, including 82 children, 51 women and 14 victims under torture.

The death toll in Deir Ezzor, classified according to the parties reportedly responsible for the killings:

The Assad's forces: in the first half of 2019, the Assad's forces have killed 30 civilians in Deir Ezzor province, including 3 children and 9 victims under torture. The network also documented the killing of 12 fighters by the Assad's forces.

Daesh: In the first half of 2019, Daesh has killed 118 civilians from Deir Ezzor, including 21 children and 22 women.

Hay'at Tahrir al-Sham: Hay'at Tahrir Al-Sham has killed two civilians from Deir Ezzor province.

The International coalition: In the first half of 2019, The International coalition has killed 71 civilians from Deir Ezzor province, including 22 children and 16 women.

The Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF): In the first half of 2019, the SDF has killed 58 civilians in Deir Ezzor province, including 16 children, 4 women, and 3 victims under torture.

Others: Deir Ezzor 24 network has documented the killing of 99 civilians from Deir Ezzor province, who have been killed in different ways by different parties, and the victims included 20 children, 9 women, and 2 victims under torture.

Deir Ezzor 24 network works through an integrated team in and outside Deir Ezzor province to document the numbers of civilian victims from Deir Ezzor, who are killed by the parties involved in the conflict, in an attempt to identify the perpetrators of these violations, and to create an accurate database that would hold them accountable for their crimes against the people of Deir Ezzor province.
