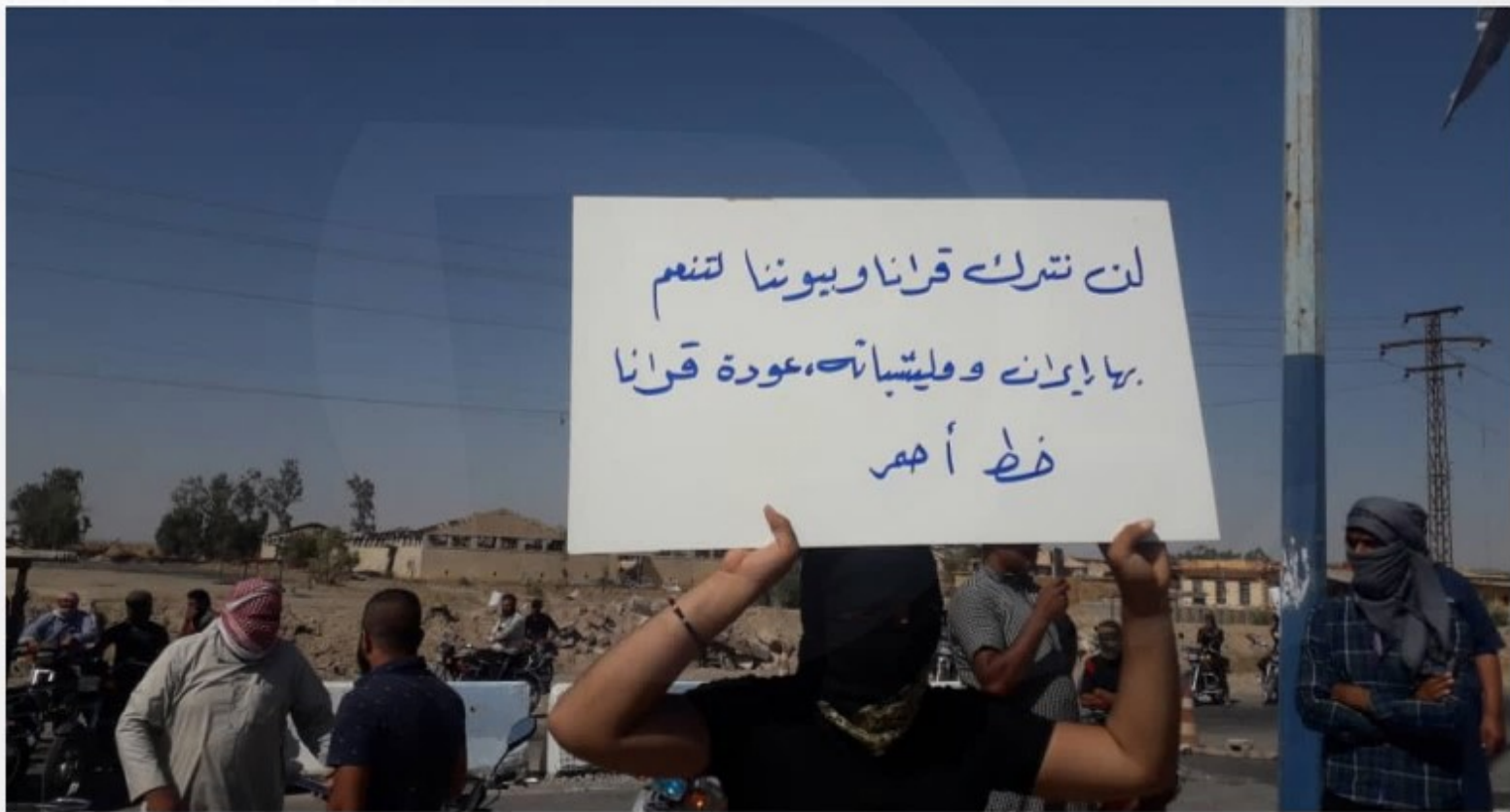

For the second consecutive Friday, protests are held in Deir Ezzor against the Assad regime and Iran

Friday 27-9-2019, protests were held in several areas under the slogan "Al-Salhiyah Martyrs Friday", according to Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent. Our correspondent said that after Friday prayers, hundreds of Deir Ezzor's people marched to the industrial zone roundabout near Al-Salhiyah town, where they gathered and shouted slogans against the Iranian militias and Assad forces, demanding that they leave villages and towns east of the Euphrates. Our correspondent added that the protesters raised slogans in support of Idlib province, and other ones glorifying the Syrian revolution. Our correspondent noted that the Syrian democratic forces (SDF) tried to prevent the protesters from entering Al-Salhiyah town north of Deir Ezzor through setting up temporary checkpoints at the entrance of the town, but the protesters were able to pass them, approaching the crossings controlled by Assad's forces in Al-Salhiyah. This Friday was given this name after a number of civilians were killed by Assad's forces during last Friday's protests. It is indicated that for the second consecutive Friday, protests took place in Deir Ezzor countryside to demand the Assad's forces and the Iranian militias leave the eastern Euphrates in order for the displaced people to be able to return to their homes in the areas controlled by Assad's forces east of the Euphrates, such as the towns of Hatlah, Marrat, Khasham, Tabiya Jazeera and Al-Salhiyah.

The Assad's forces torture two demonstrators before killing them



Two civilians, “Abdul Razzaq Khalaf al-Rahil” and “Mohammed Jadaan al-Abbad”, were shot dead by the Assad’s forces in Al-Salhiyah town north of Deir Ezzor, according to Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent. Our correspondent pointed out that the two youths were killed by elements of Assad’s forces after being shot by Al-Salhiya checkpoint elements, who opened heavy gunfire on the demonstrators. The correspondent confirmed that the bodies of the two youths had signs of torture on them, which indicates that they had been tortured and abused before being killed. The bodies of the two young men were exchanged with a number of the Assad’s forces arrested elements, through some intermediaries from the area. It is noteworthy that mass demonstrations started today in several areas of Deir Ezzor countryside and headed towards Al-Salhiya crossing north of Deir Ezzor, demanding the expulsion of the Assad forces and Iranian militias from the eastern Euphrates areas.

Life gradually returns to Al-Baghuz and a comprehensive service project begins there

A few days ago, in the presence of some elders and intellectuals of the town, the Civil Council of Al-Baghuz town announced the launch of a comprehensive service project, according to Deir ezzor 24 network correspondent. According to local sources, the project aims to remove the rubble, maintain the roads and rehabilitate the infrastructure in Al-Baghuz town. The project duration is three months, and renewable, according to an official of the civil council. There will be also a medical body to remove the decomposing bodies from streets, public buildings and homes. In addition, water tanks will be provided to supply free water to homes, 10 barrels per house. The project will cover all the neighbourhoods of Al-Baghuz town, including Al-Baghuz Tahtani area. It is worth mentioning that Al-Baghuz town suffered large-scale destruction, as a result of the battles that took place between the international coalition and the SDF on the one hand and Daesh on the other, where fighting lasted for several months, causing large destruction and victims, and forced the people of Al-Baghuz to flee their town.

Women and children from Deir Ezzor and al-Raqqa leave Al-Hol camp

Deir Ezzor 24 network learned from sources that 36 women and children from Al-Raqqa and Deir Ezzor governorates left al-Hol camp in Al-Hasakah countryside this afternoon. The sources added that the women and children lived in Al-Hol camp for nearly six months after being displaced from their areas due to fighting between the international coalition and the SDF on the one hand and Daesh on the other. The same sources confirmed that the women and their children were allowed to leave the camp after it was proven that they were civilians, and also as they wanted to return to their homes. Al-Hol camp is home to thousands of displaced people from various provinces, mostly from eastern provinces, and a number of families of Daesh elements who were killed or escaped during the recent fighting in the Deir Ezzor countryside.

The Revolutionary Guard militia begins establishing new military headquarters in Al-Mayadeen

Monday, sources revealed to Deir Ezzor 24 network that the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia is preparing to establish military bases for its forces near Al-Mayadeen city in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside. The sources indicated that the military bases would be set up near the sheep market in Al-Mayadeen city, and that the Revolutionary Guard militia had seized sheepfolds in the area and transformed them into military headquarters. The sources added that new military headquarters are being established and equipped through Iranian organizations led by Jihad al-Binaa and al-Hussein organizations. The sources noted that the bases would be dedicated for the members who joined the Revolutionary Guard in Deir Ezzor, and that checkpoints would be erected at some distance from those new headquarters. The Revolutionary Guard militia also set up military and security stations inside al-Mayadeen town in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside. The movements of the Iranian militias synchronized with increased air strikes on their forces in the syrian-Iraqi border city of Al-Bukamal



Hatlah mayor.. a life full of Tashbih, Spying and spreading of Shiism



Younis al-Zahir, known as "Abu Adnan", is the mayor of Hatlah. He is from Al-Bubadran tribes, al-Zahir family, who along with al-Raja, al-Mayouf and Al Hammadi, have have been spreading Shiism in Hatlah for decades. e joined the Baath Party a long time ago and was appointed mayor of Hatlah after the former mayor died in 2012. l-Zahir previously worked with the Assad regime on several tasks, including spreading Shiism, spying on protesters, and participating in the suppression of demonstrations staged against the Assad regime in 2011, where he used his sons and nephews as spies to collect information about protesters and members of the Free Army. fter the Free Syrian Army took control of most parts of Deir Ezzor province including Hatlah town in 11 / 6 / 2013, al-Zahir denied that he and his family had converted to the Shiite faith, and when the Free Army stormed Hatlah town for the second time, no one was able to arrest anyone from al-Zahir family as they had relatives in the Free Army. Younis al-Zahir continued to live his normal life while the Free Army was controlling the area, communicating secretly with the Assad regime and giving it information about the FSA and the area. fter Daesh took control of Hatlah and the surrounding areas, Al-Zahir immediately showed his repentance to the organization, but Daesh arrested him on charges of involvement in al-Seiyasiyah Bridge bombing as there were evidence against him. He was also accused of bringing weapons into Hatlah village during the siege, and sending food into the areas of the Assad forces control on the opposite bank of the Euphrates river, but he managed to escape and hide from the organization for a long time. After the Assad's forces, Russia, and the Iranian militias took control of Hatlah town in late 2017, he welcomed the forces that entered the town, and held a large feast for the officers and officials, celebrating their control over parts of the province at the expense of Daesh. He then joined the Syrian Branch of Hezbollah militia and began carrying out his tasks, mainly spreading Shiism, and encouraging youths to join the Iranian militias. "Al-Zahir" now works under the wing of the Iranian militias in the province, and is considered one of the influential figures in the region extending from Hatlah town to the villages of Marat, Khasham and Tabiya Jazeera. He seeks through his activities to reach high status in Tehran, and to be one of its most important men in Deir Ezzor and the region as a whole.

Elements of the Assad militias were killed and wounded in Deir Ezzor



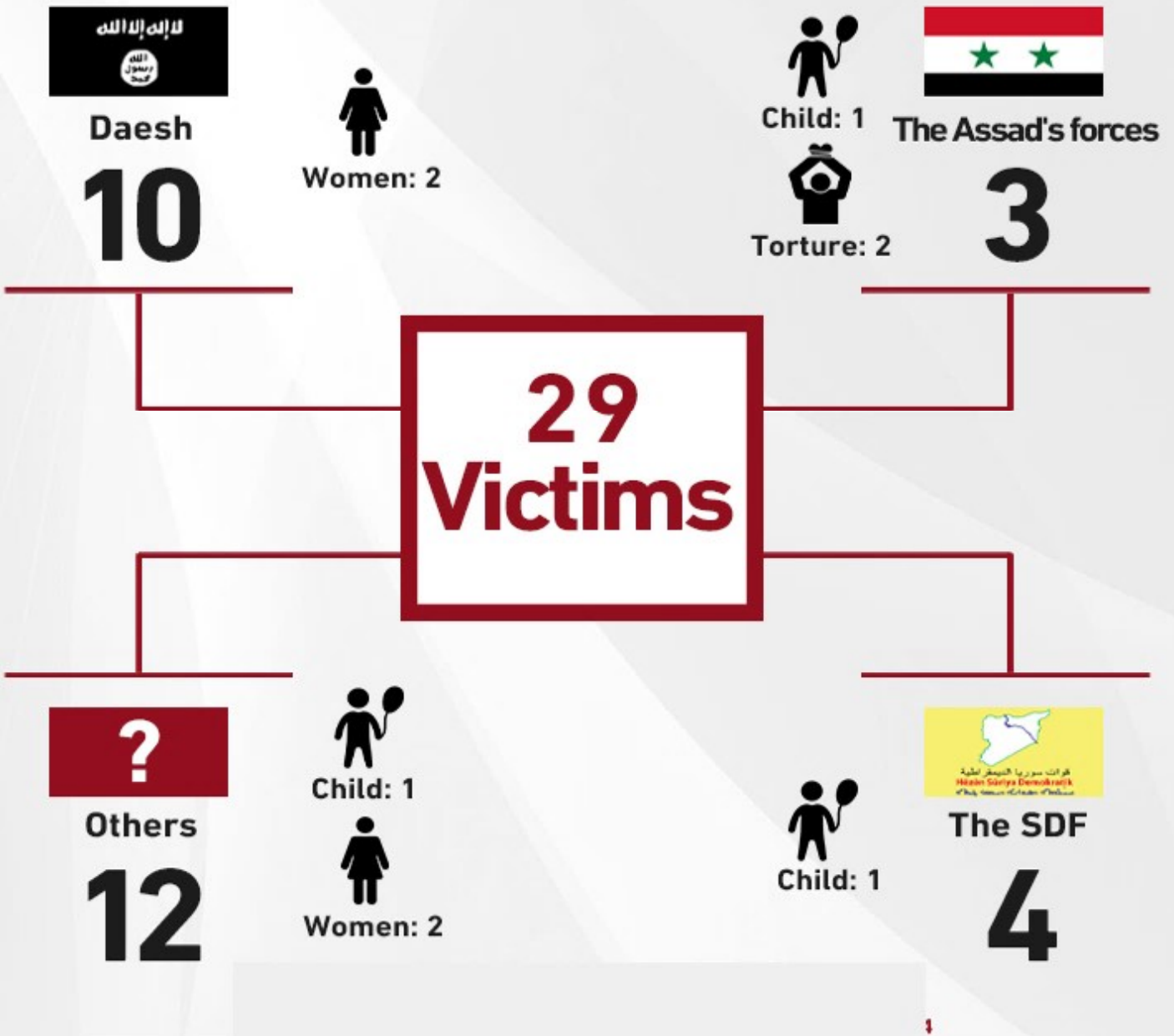
Two elements of the Assad's forces were killed and others were wounded in an attack by Daesh on several areas of Deir Ezzor countryside, Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent reported. According to our correspondent, during the past two days, the organization launched sporadic attacks, targeting military points of the Assad's force and their militias that have them in the badiyah of al-Mayadeen, Al-Quriyah, Sbikhan, Al-Ishara and the area near the badiyah of Hreibsha, which resulted in the killing and wounding of a number of the Assad forces elements:

- 1- Abdullah Hafel al-Khidher**
- 2- Yahya Jaber al-Ahmad.**

Daesh occasionally carries out military attacks west of the Euphrates, targeting areas controlled by the Assad's forces, because of which the forces suffer continuous losses of life and materiel.

Al-Bukhabour tribe forms a tribal body in Deir Ezzor



On September 27th, the elders of “al-Bukhbour” tribe in Al-Azbah village convened a meeting of the tribe members in northeastern Syria to form a tribal body to represent the tribe, sources told Deir Ezzor 24 network. The meeting was attended by a number of dissident officers, doctors, engineers, teachers and the tribe’s prominent figures. The aim of the meeting was to unite the tribe’s members who have been separated by the war, ensure that their rights are protected, form a body to represent the tribe in the political circles, and to demand their return to their areas controlled by the Iranian militias. The sources pointed out that the attendants agreed to form committees from the tribe’s members with different functions, such as the Public Relations Committee, Humanitarian Organizations committee and Services committee, and there will be an announcement of the formation of “al-Bukhabour tribe Gathering” in northeastern Syria during this week. According to the sources, al-Bukhabour tribe members who live abroad will have the right to join this gathering through offering material or moral support to their displaced people. It is noteworthy that al-Bukhabour tribe is one of the major tribes in Deir Ezzor, and its members are highly concentrated in Muhassan and al-Merayah cities and Al-Buamir town in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside.
