## A civilian is robbed in his home in Deir Ezzor by cells working under the name of Daesh



The civilian “Khedher al-Huwaish”, the owner of al-Huwaish bakery in Al-Azbah area north of Deir Ezzor, was beaten at his home last night by a gang claiming to belong to Daesh, according to Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent. Our correspondent added, that al-Huwaish was repeatedly threatened by unknown men who demanded him two weeks ago to pay them \$10,000 and two pistols, otherwise he will be killed, but al-Huwaish did not listen to the threatenings, so the gang broke into his house, beat him and stole 5 million Syrian pounds, two Kalashnikovs and his car. It is noteworthy that this incident is the second of its kind in few days, where a similar incident occurred few days ago in Ash-Shahil city but the resident were able to arrest one member of the gang and kill another. All fingers point to former elements of Daesh, and cells belonging to the Assad regime.

## The Coalition carries out an extensive security campaign in Deir Ezzor...and the arrest of an emir of Daesh is the first of its results

Sources revealed to Deir Ezzor 24 network that a former Daesh leader was arrested along with a number of members in a security operation by the international coalition and the SDF , Sunday 10-11-2019, in Al-Hawayej town east of Deir Ezzor. The sources said that through a special operation, the attacking force of the Coalition was able to arrest a Daesh leader, Hammam al-Lafi known as "Abu al-Harith", who was one of the emirs of the Zakat department in the organization, along with a group of former members of the organization. These arrests were part of an intensive campaign carried out by the coalition and the Syrian democratic forces "SDF" against the cells and remnants of Daesh in the towns and villages of Deir Ezzor countryside (eastern Euphrates). The same sources noted, that the security campaign carried out by the international Coalition and the SDF has begun on Friday 8-11-2019, starting from Jedid Bakara and Jedid Akidat villages up to Al-Hawayej and Diban. Also Ash-Shahil city witnessed a military campaign last night by the coalition and the SDF on the water crossings linking Ash-Shahil with Buqruss town on the other bank, which is controlled by Assad's forces. During the operation, the military force led by the coalition clashed with smugglers from the area. This incident coincides with reports of the Coalition intention to close the water crossings with Assad's forces after releasing statements about protecting the oil installations east of the Euphrates. The campaign will continue to cover the majority of Deir Ezzor areas (east of the Euphrates) as a result of the increased operations of Daesh remnants and sleeper cells in the area. During the last period, Daesh cells have been carrying out kidnapping and killings against civilians and military personnel, and threatening all people dealing with the SDF and the coalition through dropping leaflets in several villages and towns that are controlled by the Coalition. It is indicated that the international coalition occasionally launches security operations against Daesh cells in the region, which exposes civilians and the elements of the international Coalition and the SDF to direct danger.

## A priest is killed in Deir Ezzor and Daesh claims responsibility for the operation!

Deir Ezzor **24** network correspondent said that the priest “Hoseib Abraham Beidoyan” and his father “Hanna Ibrahim Beido” were killed by gunmen this morning, Monday, in Deir Ezzor province. Hours after the incident, Daesh claimed responsibility for the killing of the priest and his father in a statement it posted on its platforms on social media. The priest, Hoseib Abraham, from Qamishli city in Hasakeh governorate, is the pastor of the Armenian Catholic Church “Mar Yousef” in Qamishli. He was in his car with his father and two people on their way to Deir Ezzor province on a mission for the church when they were attacked, according to statements by people close to the priest. It is indicated that Daesh cells are active in the areas of Deir Ezzor that are controlled by the international coalition and the SDF (east of the Euphrates), and these cells carry out killings and kidnappings, but are met with successive security operations by the international coalition and the SDF.



## Advanced U.S. logistical and military equipment arrive in Deir Ezzor



Sources revealed to Deir Ezzor **24** network that new military equipment for the international coalition arrived in Deir Ezzor in the past few days. According to the sources, military equipment, including advanced radars, arrived at Conoco field, that is taken as a base by the international coalition, and the radars were activated there on Friday morning. It is noteworthy that the international coalition has expanded its presence in Deir Ezzor over the past period, by deploying forces in new areas of Deir Ezzor, in addition to bringing military and logistical equipment following the statement of the American administration about keeping their forces to protect oil installations in the north and east of Syria.

## A gang operating under the name of Daesh is arrested by Ash-Shahil people

Sunday **3-11-2019**, a group of Ash-Shahil town's people (al-Barghout Branch) arrested a gang operating under the name of Daesh in Ash-Shahil town in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside, Deir Ezzor **24** network correspondent reported. In the details, our correspondent said, that a group of men "al-Barghout Branch" in Ash-Shahil town ambushed a gang of robbers that were imposing taxes, and carrying out robberies and kidnappings in the area after the gang imposed a tax on a gas station owner in the town, and when **4** of them came to the gas station to collect the money, the group of al-Barghout Branch clashed with them, and were able to kill one person and catch another while the other two persons escaped. The person who was killed is from Azzir village, from al-Watteb family, while the identity of the arrested person has not been revealed yet. After preliminary investigations, it was found that the members of the gang are remnants of Daesh, where after the organization was ended in the region, they formed a group under the name of the organization.



Deir Ezzor **24** network manager meets with the special envoy to Syria in Geneva... Deir Ezzor protests are of concern to the Americans





Deir Ezzor 24 network executive manager, Mr. Omar Abu Layla, met with Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for Near Eastern Affairs and Special Envoy to Syria, Joel Rayburn, in Geneva, Switzerland. The meeting discussed a number of important issues, including recent developments in Deir Ezzor province east of Syria, most notably the continued presence of U.S. forces in the region, as well as the constitutional committee that is being discussed by the Syrian opposition with the Assad regime under the United Nations auspices. Rayburn said that the United States supports the rights of protesters who have been recently protesting in Deir Ezzor, noting that his country has seen these protests and reported on them to the U.S. leadership. Joel Rayburn added that the protesters' demands in Deir Ezzor are rightful, and that Washington stands by the people, and emphasizes the need to remove the Iranian threat from the region, to keep the region safe for people to live in. The American official indicated that the U.S. leadership still considers Iran as a threat to the region, and that the protesters demands are rightful and must be met. The U.S. official stressed that his country will continue to put pressure on Daesh, and prevent it from reaching the region's oil wealth, noting that also the Assad regime and the Iranians will not benefit from it, and that the U.S. forces will halt the Assad regime's ambitions to control oil and gas in Deir Ezzor. The network's executive manager told the official about the suffering of the people of Deir Ezzor, both at the local level, and at the security level in relation with the dangers of Iran. He also emphasized the need to work on development projects to meet the people's needs in the region. Abu Layla stressed that the U.S. forces presence is necessary especially in the current period to ensure security and stability in the region. He also underlined the need to intensify the security measures against Daesh in Deir Ezzor countryside, as it has been active in the region through bombings and assassinations. For his part, Deputy Assistant Secretary of State for Near Eastern Affairs and Special Envoy to Syria Joel Rayburn said that Washington will continue to work with its local partners at all levels.
