Deir Ezzor 24 obtains new details about the landing operation carried out in Al-Tukayhi



Deir Ezzor 24 network obtained new details about the landing operation carried out by the international Coalition against Daesh cells in Al-Tukayhi town in Deir Ezzor countryside. In the details, the international coalition forces, with the participation of the SDF, managed to kill Ragheb Hussein Ahmed al-Ibrahim, a leader of Daesh, following violent clashes near his home. Military sources confirmed to Deir Ezzor 24 network, that the leader in Daesh "Ragheb al-Ibrahim", is the security official for the activities of Daesh cells in several areas of Deir Ezzor countryside, especially the area known as the Triangle "Al-Bassirah - Ash-Shahil - Al-Tukayhi". The international coalition forces were also able to kill an element of Daesh after he clashed with the SDF, and arrested four people suspected to be Daesh elements in Deir Ezzor countryside. The security operation also resulted in the killing of Abdul Hamid al-Faihan, an element of the 6th Regiment of the SDF, and the injury of a number of elements, as a result of the clash with Daesh cells. According to the military sources, the international coalition forces and the SDF found an arms depot of Daesh near the railway in the area.

Kaser al-Habash, Iran's obedient broker



Since it took control of Deir Ezzor, Iran has recruited a number of the city's people to carry out its project in the province. Kaser al-Habash, was one of the first people to pledge allegiance to Iran since it brought its militias' to the territory of Deir Ezzor. Al-Habash is from Deir Ezzor, Al-Joura neighborhood. He is 55 years old. He previously worked as a crane driver, in addition to running some small businesses. At the beginning of the Syrian revolution, Al-Habash's activity began to increase through reporting to and cooperation with the Assad regime's security branches. When Al-Joura came under seige in late 2014, al-Habash was appointed as the mayor of Al-Joura, and remained the neighborhood's mayor until the Assad's forces and the Iranian militias entered Deir Ezzor in 2017. And as soon as the Iranian militias entered Deir Ezzor, al-Habash was one of the first to bow and scrap before the militias, and openly embraced the Shiite faith. Al-Habash was given the task of attracting the young men to embrace Shiism, in addition to his main work as a broker, helping the Iranian to buy the properties of the civilians in Deir Ezzor. Al-Habash has a good relation with the Security Branches of the Assad regime, in addition to the privileges he has got from the Iranians for the services he has provided, and from time to time he goes to Damascus to show allegiance to the Shiite religious leaders in Sayyida Zeinab area.

On June 17, 2019, Daraj site published an interview conducted by the journalist Hazem al-Amin with the senior leader of Daesh Saddam Al-Gamal, who was arrested by the U.S. and the Turkish intelligence, who in turn handed him over to the Iraqi intelligence, along with a group of Daesh leaders who tried to escape from Syria to Iraq in May, 2018. As soon as the press of the Iraqi government were allowed to conduct interviews, some of these interviews, in which al-Gamal talked about the period he had gone through from 2011 until the moment of his arrest, started to appear, where in each interview he recounted all the details of his personal life and how he lived before the Syrian revolution "as a smuggler of tobacco following his father in this work", and how he joined the Free Army, and then how Jabhat al-Nusra antagonized him killing his three brothers, and how later he became an enemy of Daesh, and then surrendered himself to the organization and became a senior leader in it until the end when he was arrested and dressed in that suit whose color changes every time he appears, once in orange and another time in yellow and it is not known what color his suit will be the next interviews if there is any again. In one of his interviews, Al-Gamal seemed relaxed while telling the details as if he did not care about the fate he will face, he still denies the charges made against him of committing many massacres, including the slaughter of Al-Shaitat that Daesh committed against Al-Shaitat tribe, killing more than 800 of them after they rose up against the organization and opposed it.

Saddam al-Gamal He lies & He is a liar



In each interview, Saddam recounts the same story in which he exaggerated to himself that he was a key decision-maker in the province and that many battalions, brigades and armies were following his orders and even obeying him in every thing he wants, explaining that he was occupying an important position in the general staff of the Free Army, but the fact that many people do not know about Saddam al-Gamal, is that during the formation of the Free Army general Staff, he threatened the factions of the Free Army that if he did not take up a position in the region, he would make a counter-revolution, and perhaps he and those with him would become enemies from behind against any one targets the regime in Deir Ezzor. He always tries to gain sympathy from those who don't know who he really is, by telling the story about the killing of his brothers and the bombing of his house, where he shows that he is a poor lamb that is always targeted by all, and he evaluates himself that he was an important person in the area .. otherwise, what do you think? Saddam Al-Jamal is like dozens or even hundreds of Daesh leaders from the Syrian smugglers, thieves and bandits whom the organization, during its period of foundation, attracted to strengthen itself in the province, and it succeeded with this plan, attracting al-Gamal, Amer al-Rafdan, Abu Saif al-Shaiti and dozens of other Syrians to its ranks and luring them with positions and the free movement to do every thing they like. This was a turning point for al-Gamal when he turned against all the factions of the Free Army, claiming that it was all about his brothers being targeted by Jabhat al-Nusra at that time, and that he would pledge allegiance to Daesh only to avenge Al-Nusra although Jabhat al-Nusra had already left Deir Ezzor province by that time to several syrian provinces, including Idlib, Aleppo and other areas, so what revenge was he talking about when there were no more any fighters of al-Nusra in Deir Ezzor if this really was his reason? What we can't forget is that al-Gamal was part of Ahfad al-Rasoul brigade that was formed by the dissident major Maher al-Nuaimi, and during the fighting of Ahfad al-Rasoul Brigade against Daesh in Al-Ragga province in late 2013, al-Gamal was delaying a lot in supporting his fellow fighters of the Free army who were in the same faction he was leading, but in another province, Ragga, this was doubtful for the Syrians, especially the people of the region, when they discovered that he was plotting even against his fighters, then all that was clear when he handed over the weapons and appeared in a video by Daesh, surrendering him self at first to his fellow thief Amer al-Rafdan – who didn't get what he sought for during the control of the Free Army, and found it in Daesh organization – later he showed repentance to the organization which pardoned him and gave him what he wanted, especially that the Free Army and Jabhat al-Nusra in Deir Ezzor and Raqqa fought against Daesh in that time period, so it attracted him, gave him those positions and fueled his hatred pushing him to take revenge, which led to many tragedies in many areas, the most serious of which is Al-Shaitat massacre, for which al-Gamal was responsible as a planner and actor. There is no doubt that the lies al-Gamal tells in each interview are much more than some of the truths he says as he is involved in many egregious crimes which he committed either before he joined the organization or even after that. No one knows Saddam al-Gamal better than the people of the region, especially those who knew him at the beginning of the revolution and how he thinks, where he uses these interviews in a vain attempt to gain sympathy from some of those who watch him and do not know his past and how he harmed the people of his city "Al-Bukamal" before he became a wanted criminal whose hands were stained with the blood of Deir Ezzor's people in general. Through the interviews, Saddam seeks to pass messages that may give him the right to life, which he and Daesh had taken away from thousands of Syrians who were killed by the organization and its elements in cold blood. What is the just fate that al-Gamal and those with him will face? And how long will it take?





A violent clash breaks out between Daesh and the Assad's forces in Deir Ezzor

Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent said that Daesh organization launched an attack on the Assad's forces in Deir Ezzor. The correspondent indicated that the attack took place west of Deir Ezzor, where groups of Daesh attacked military posts of the Assad's forces in Al-Kharitah and Al-Bughayliya villages in the western Deir Ezzor countryside. Our correspondent added that a violent clash erupted between the two parties, during which medium and light weapons were used, and lasted for about an hour and a half. It is indicated that Daesh occasionally carries out such operations against the Assad's forces in Deir Ezzor countryside, in the areas controlled by the Assad regime, the Russian forces and the Iranian militias.



Deir Ezzor 24 Network manager meets with Ambassador James Jeffrey and the Special Envoy for Syria and Deputy Assistant Secretary of State

Deir Ezzor 24 network manager, Mr. Omar Abu Layla, met with the US Deputy Assistant Secretary for Levant affairs and special envoy for Syria Joel Rayburn, Wednesday 24.07.2019 in Germany. The meeting lasted for more than two and a half hours, during which they discussed many issues and matters related to Deir Ezzor governorate, including the real danger posed by the Iranian presence, Daesh, providing services to the region, reconstruction, and supporting all aspects of the province's economy. Mr. Rayburn stressed the importance of eradicating Daesh entirely from the region and eliminating even the remnants of its ideas and the effects it has left in the region. He also stressed that the stability of the region is very important for the United States of America in the current and the next stage. As for the Iranian presence in the province, he stressed that the United States of America will not allow this entity to exist and is working to remove it from all of Syria not just from Deir Ezzor. The special envoy to Syria stressed that Deir Ezzor should have a strong economy that serves its people, especially that it has the necessary qualifications for this economy. He stressed that it is important for everyone to work for the province, and that the United States and its international partners are committed to supporting the region, especially after eliminating Daesh. Ambassador James Jeffrey joined the meeting for a short time, and stressed the importance of these meetings and communicating closely, in addition to activating all the initiatives that serve the region and help local population build their own lives and future as they dream.


The details of the military operation carried out by the SDF and the coalition in al-Shaitat



On July 27, 2019, the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF) carried out a security operation in Abu Hamam town, targeting Daesh elements responsible for the attack on the town's market on July 7, which led to the killing of three children. Several Daesh fighters were captured, and 8 RPGs, more than 7,500 AK-47 rounds, dozens of grenades, radios and mobile phones were seized. During the operation, a fighter of Daesh opened fire on the Syrian democratic forces, who responded to the fire and managed to kill him, without any reports of casualties among civilians. In the same operation, some of those associated with Daesh were also arrested. It is noteworthy that Daesh cells are still active and carry out military operations in different areas of Deir Ezzor countryside which are under the control of the SDF.

After several assassination attempts... a military commander is killed by unidentified perpetrators in Deir Ezzor



Friday 26-7-2019, Yasser al-Dahla, a military commander of the SDF military council, was killed in Deir Ezzor. According to Deir ezzor 24 correspondent, al-Dahla was ambushed along with a group of elements accompanying him on al-Kharafi road linking al-Hasakah with Deir Ezzor. Our correspondent pointed out that "al-Dahla" was on a visit to Al-Hasakah to carry out a tribal reconciliation, and while returning from Al-Hasakah, unidentified assailants, believed to be Daesh elements, in three cars targeted his car with machine guns near Bridge 47, killing him and injuring a number of his escorts. It is noteworthy that Al-Dahala has been subjected to three previous assassination attempts. He had previously served as a military commander of the Free Syrian Army's Thi Qar brigade, then moved to al-Qalamoun and then to the northern Aleppo countryside, before joining Deir Ezzor Military Council.

Informed sources revealed to Deir Ezzor 24 network the details of the visit made by the commander of the Quds Force of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard "Qasem Soleimani" to Al-Bukamal city in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside. The sources confirmed that Soleimani arrived in Al-Bukamal, met with the Revolutionary Guard leadership in the city, and began a tour of the Iranian forces' sectors in the city. The sources indicated that Soleimani visited al-Qaim border crossing with Iraq, and called on his forces in the area to seek to reopen the crossing between the two countries. The sources noted that Iranian militias prevented the Assad's forces and the National Defense from accompanying Soleimani on his tour of the region, and asked them to stick to their headquarters. The sources added that the majority of the Iranian militias did not know about Soleimani's visit, and he encouraged them to fight terrorism and to be prepared for any possible battle. The Quds Force commander Soleimani, accompanied by an interpreter, also met with the Syrian elements who have recently joined the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, where the meeting lasted for about 35 minutes. Regarding the details of the meeting, the sources confirmed that Soleimani thanked them for joining his forces, explaining that Iran came to help the Syrians in fighting terrorism. Soleimani called on the Syrian elements to encourage the other Syrians in the areas outside the Assad regime control to return to their cities and join his forces in Deir Ezzor, promising that they will not be pursued by the security, and that he will seek to resolve their situation. It is noteworthy that Qasem Soleimani conducted a battle to control al-Bukamal city in October 2017, where the city is very important for Iran strategically and militarily.
