

The Iranian militias seize houses in Al-Mayadeen and raise sectarian slogans

The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia seized a house belonging to a civilian in al-Tammu neighborhood in Al-Mayadeen city in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside. According to exclusive details obtained by Deir Ezzor 24 network, the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia began raising their flags and writing sectarian slogans on the walls of the houses it had seized after turning them into security and military headquarters. According sources, the Iranian militias closed some streets in al-Tammu neighborhood in Al-Mayadeen city, taking the area as security zone for their forces in the city. The Iranian militias raised their flags in Al-Mayadeen after the Quds force commander in the Iranian Revolutionary "Qasem Soleimani visited the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside, meeting with the militia elements. It is indicated that after taking control of Al-Mayadeen city in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside, Iran turned al-Tammu neighborhood into a closed military zone, in addition, it is an operations room for the Iranian forces in the city. The Iranian militias prevented the families living in al-Tammu neighborhood from returning to it as their elements seized civilian homes in the neighborhood, which is one of the most important sites of the Iranian forces in the area.

Deir ezzor 24 network monitors the second case of Mutah (sighe) marriage in Deir Ezzor



Sources confirmed to Deir Ezzor 24 network that a case of the so-called "Mutah marriage" took place in Al-Bukamal city, the easternmost part of Deir Ezzor province. The sources pointed out that the marriage was held between an Iranian official named "Haj Suleiman" and a girl from Al-Sukariyah village near the western entrance to Al-Bukamal city. The sources also confirmed that the sighe contract between the two parties lasts for six months according to an agreement between the two parties. The same sources indicated that the girl's brothers are elements in the Revolutionary Guard militia in Al-Bukamal. It is worth mentioning that this is the second case of Mutah marriage to be recorded in Deir Ezzor, where the first one occurred in the so-called "Ein al-Ali" site in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside which Iran has transformed to a Shiite shrine, in November of 2018, where Deir Ezzor 24 Network monitored and published its details on the same date. It is indicated that the Iranian militias have been in control of al-Bukamal since late 2017, where they pay special attention to the city and seek to attract as many civilians as they can to the Shiite faith through recruiting them in the militias, tempting them with money, or granting them privileges over ordinary civilians.



Al-Sha'itat massacre in Deir Ezzor the 5th anniversary

which is one of the largest massacres in the history of the Syrian revolution after the chemical massacre in Eastern Ghouta. It was committed by Daesh against Al-Shaitat tribe members in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside as a result of their uprising against the organization during its takeover of Deir Ezzor province in 2014. Between 1,000 and 1,200 people, mostly civilians, including women and children, were killed as a result of the massacre, according to documentations made by activists and human rights organizations, the numbers of the victims had increased many times for one year from the date of the massacre due to the discovery of mass graves in the area. Through the massacre carried out against Al-Shaitat members, Daesh wanted to send a message to all those who oppose it in Deir Ezzor, which it had recently entered, and was seeking to force it into obedience after it was rejected by Deir Ezzor's people at the beginning of its emergence in the province, so the massacre came as a response to the uprising carried out by Al-Shaitat tribe against Daesh after it took control of the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside due to its bloody practices in the region, which fuelled resentment against it, and led to uprising against it. Where a number of Daesh members were killed, and its presence in several areas of the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside rapidly receded, which forced it to bring in new reinforcements from Iraq to quell the uprising and begin a mass retaliation against the population, killing them according to their identity and displacing them from their homes Al-Shaitat tribe lives in Al-Kashkiyah, Abu Hamam and Granij towns in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside. Its members are estimated at 120,000 people. Daesh displaced them from these towns, and did not allowed them to return to their homes until nearly a year later. It is worth mentioning that the fighters of Al-Shaitat tribe played a major role in fighting Daesh and expelling it from the area, as they had fought on several fronts since their departure from Deir Ezzor, most notably the fronts of the northern Aleppo countryside, They were the cornerstone in defending the region and facing the successive attacks of Daesh.

Angry youths close a hospital in Deir Ezzor and the reasons

A group of young people from Al-Bassirah city attacked the city's hospital, according to Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent. The correspondent noted that the young people attacked the hospital after they asked the administrator for jobs in the hospital, and threatened him that if he did not close the hospital immediately, they would target the hospital with weapons, which led the administrator to evacuate it from the patients and send the employees and the medical staff to their homes for their own safety. Our correspondent noted that five newborns were in the incubators during the attack and were discharged from hospital after the administrator received the threats from the young men. He also confirmed that a military group of the SDF surrounded the hospital and imposed a security cordon around it in case of any possible threat. It is indicated that the hospital has been closed since this afternoon, while the SDF patrols are pursuing the youths to catch them and take the appropriate action.

Al-Hol camp.... a big prison and sufferings without solutions

Thousands of people of Deir Ezzor, Ragga and Hasakeh countrysides live in extremely dire humanitarian conditions in al-Hol camp in Hasakeh countryside. Deir ezzor 24 network was able to enter the camp and see the current situation of the displaced people there, especially those coming from Deir Ezzor countryside. The camp is divided into several sections according to the sides from which the camp's inhabitants came, where Daesh families live in isolation from other civilians displaced from the eastern region or from Iraq. The camp suffers from very difficult medical conditions, as there is not any hospital there, except for very simple medical points inside the camp that can't deal with critical situations. The sanitation in the camp is the main problem, where there are no sewer system to keep the waste water away from the tents of the displaced people. The camp has a population of about 65,000 people, twice its capacity, according to international organizations led by the United Nations. The number of Daesh members inside the camp is estimated at 10195 members, including children and women belonging to 45 nationalities, who live in the camp isolated from the rest of its inhabitants . Nearly 15,000 children are without schools in the camp, amid persistent efforts to integrate them into the camp's simple educational centres, but with very little success. The people of Deir Ezzor countryside have been calling on the Syrian democratic forces (SDF) to allow the IDPs to return to their homes, which are now free of Daesh, but these calls were met with difficult measures imposed by the SDF on the inhabitants of the camp, justifying that with the "Security imperatives". The Syrian democratic forces and the self-administration committees allowed hundreds of civilians to leave Al-Hol camp to Al-Tabga town in the western Ragga countryside, following tribal mediation. Deir Ezzor 24 was able to take a number of exclusive photographs of al-Hol camp in Al-Hasakeh countryside, showing the difficult conditions of the camp's inhabitants and their every day lives.

A security meeting is held in Al-Bukamal about al-Qaim crossing

Monday 5 – August, sources revealed to Deir Ezzor 24 network, that a security meeting was held between the intelligence of the Assad regime and Iranian security officials in Al-Bukamal city east of Deir Ezzor. The sources indicated that the meeting focused on the working mechanism of the Al-Bukamal-Al-Qaim crossing, which is likely to open early next month, and that the Assad regime and the Iranian officials have drawn up an action plan for the crossing. The parties agreed that the Assad regime's customs and civilian police should be deployed at the crossing, and that the Iranian military and security presence should not come to eyes of people. The meeting was held to finalize the reopening of the crossing, which Iran attaches great importance to, given that it links its militias in Iraq with the others in Syria. Iran relies on a military crossing near al-Kam oil terminal near Al-Bukamal city in transporting weapons and elements to Syria, and it is one of Iran's most important military crossings on the Syrian-Iraqi border. It is noteworthy that the Revolutionary Guard militia and pro-Iranian militias dominate the entire city of Al-Bukamal and its countryside, and decide every thing there.



Monday, the Syrian democratic forces sent some of their leaders to Ash-Shafah town in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside, to investigate the murder of a child in the city by elements of the SDF in the area. The SDF leaders met with the father of the child who was killed and went to the place where he was killed, and examined the scene and the bullet holes, where the child was found to have been killed on purpose. The Syrian democratic forces arrested the elements of the checkpoint who had been accused of killing the child on purpose, and promised the child's family and people of the area that they will have justice against the elements who killed the child. The Syrian democratic forces called on the people of Ash-Shafah to open the roads, restore the normal movement in the city and end the civil disobedience, upon which roads were opened, roadblocks were removed and the normal movements of civilians were restored. It is indicated that the people had accused elements of the SDF of stealing shops in Street 24 in Ash-Shafah city, in addition to launching a campaign of arrests and raids in the city. It is noteworthy that the acts of the SDF elements in Ash-Shafah caused public tension in the city, where the elders of Ash-Shafah called on The leaders of the SDF to assess the latest developments and put an end to the violations of their elements in Ash-Shafah.

A clash erupts between the Revolutionary Guard and the military security in Al-Mayadeen

Tuesday, sources revealed to Deir Ezzor 24 network that two days ago, clashes erupted between the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia and the military security. The sources indicated that the clashes broke out between the two sides in the eastern neighborhood of Al-Mayadeen city, and that the Revolutionary Guard attacked the military security post and clashed with its elements. As for the main cause of the clashes, the sources confirmed that the clash came after the military security cut off the power supply to the homes of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard elements, to clamp down on its elements and push them back into the ranks of Assad's forces. The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia sent military reinforcements to its headquarters in the eastern neighborhood of Al-Mayadeen in anticipation of any developments with the military security. It is noteworthy that there is a power struggle between Iran's militias on one hand and the Assad's forces and his intelligence services in Al-Mayadeen city, during which Iran has been able to attract dozens of elements from the National

Defense and the security services to its forces in the city.
