## Alert for the Russian bridge guards in Deir Ezzor because of the Euphrates

The correspondent of the Russian battalion guarding the floating Russian bridge that connects the town of Al-Mariya and Marat said that they have been on alert for several days.

He added that for several days the militants have been firing live bullets at the floating waste on the surface of the Euphrates River, after news of the presence of mines floating in the water threatening to detonate the Russian bridge, with the aim of detonating them before they reach it.

The new earthen bridge that connects the town of Al-Husayniyyah with the city of Deir Ezzor includes, in addition to the metal pipes, a piece of a metal and wooden bridge with a length of 20 meters. It is the remains of the Halabiya and Zalabiya bridges from the northern side, and is the most abundant and allows the passage of floating materials towards the Russian bridge.

## People in Al-Bukamal turn to plastic to keep warm



DeirEzzor24 network correspondent said that many families from the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, are forced to collect plastic for use in order to use it for heating.

He added that the people's tendency to collect plastic comes after the loss of firewood and diesel from the city and the Fourth Division's emphasis on smuggling operations. ⚠️ Burning plastic for heating threatens the spread of diseases, especially those related to the respiratory system or the skin.

## **Families from Deir Ezzor refuse to receive their children's cholera vaccination**

A large number of Deir Ezzor residents in areas controlled by the Assad regime refused to have their children receive the cholera vaccine provided by the Ministry of Health, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network.

He said that the parents' refusal came because they did not trust the efficacy of the vaccine, and there were reports of vomiting and diarrhea for some of the vaccinated students.

It is worth mentioning that the vaccine consists of several oral drops given to children over the age of one year, and school students were targeted in the first phase.



## Once again, Hamsho and Al-Qaterji militias clash in Deir Ezzor



clashes broke out between al-Qaterji militia and the Hamsho militia near the town of al-Abd in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor, according to a reporter of Deir Ezzor 24 Network.

He said that the reason for the clash was a dispute over the oil trade and the management of the crossings, which evolved into the use of weapons, which led to the Al-Qatirji militia calling for reinforcements from its members at the Village Guard points to escort the tanks after a slight support of the Fourth Division of the Hamsho Group militia.

The two militias clashed in the past more than once in Deir Ezzor, after conflicting interests over controlling smuggling crossings and fuel shipments.



## **Locals in Deir Ezzor complain about poor-quality fuel oil**

A large number of local families in SDF-held areas in Deir Ezzor have complained about the poor quality of fuel oil for heating that was distributed to them by the fuel committee, according to a reporter of DeirEzzor24. He mentioned that the locals compared the distributed fuel, which is delivered by the Self-Rule Administration, to dust; adding that it freezes under lower temperatures. They also confirmed that quantities of fuel oil that are allocated to them are being smuggled toward Assad-controlled areas and replaced by poor-quality ones. It should be pointed out that several videos of such a poor quality fuel oil have gone viral on social media, amidst total silence from the Self-Rule Administration.

## **A large forgery of fuel in Deir Ezzor is revealed by Deir Ezzor 24**

DeirEzzor24 Network learned, from private sources, that the influential people in the SDF-controlled areas resort to collecting family cards (family books) from families in the Assad regime-controlled areas according to clan ties and kinship, to benefit from heating allocations in the SDF-controlled areas. He said that the records and tables of the residents of the region are being filled in partnership with the village communes, to pass the names of the forged families. He added that the number of notebooks was estimated in the thousands, and the entitlement to one notebook is 300 liters of heating oil at nominal prices, to be sold in the region at a price exceeding 1,500 pounds per liter. This forgery was described as the largest profit in the trade in heating fuel intended for the people, which leads to depriving the deserving people of their rights or decreasing them in light of the deteriorating standard of living in the region.





## Daesh attack target members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia

Daesh launched several new attacks, in the past few days, on the Al-Bukamal desert, taking advantage of the foggy atmosphere and the difficulty in reaching the sectors of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. He said that 6 members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia were killed in two operations by Daesh a few days ago, with which the organization chose the first hours of dawn, taking advantage of the dense fog in the area, which helps it to infiltrate the militia points in the desert, and among the elements who died in the attack was a member from the town of Al-Bouamr From the salaries of the clan brigade operating at the T2 station, and another from the Hama governorate belonging to the anti-mine company of the Revolutionary Guard militia, while they were patrolling on a motorcycle in the valley area on the road to Haql al-Ward-Maizilah. Also, 4 members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia were killed in an attack by ISIS on the Salihya-Al-Duwair axis in the Al-Bukamal region, east of Deir Ezzor province, and they were from the Harabish neighborhood in Deir Ezzor city. All the dead are local members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, and they are placed and imprisoned in advanced and dangerous points in the desert, while foreign elements are not involved in those fronts.



## **Sources deny to DeirEzzor24 news of the build-up of Assad's forces near the western countryside of Deir Ezzor**

DeirEzzor24 network correspondent said that the news of Assad's forces and their allies mobilizing militarily to enter the western countryside of Deir Ezzor is untrue. According to local sources, the villages and towns of western Deir Ezzor (east of the Euphrates) witnessed a high level of alert, after some opposition media pages broadcast news about Assad's forces mobilizing groups to storm the area. And the sources stated that this news came to confuse the peaceful movement spread in more than one area in the western countryside of Deir Ezzor, which aims to hold the leader of the Deir Ezzor Military Council, "Ahmed Al-Khabil" accountable, and to form a special military council for the Bakara tribe, against the background of the killing of two displaced girls in Hawajj Bu Masa'a last week. And accusing members of the Deir Ezzor Military Council who are relatives of "Ahmed Al-Khabil" of killing them. The intelligence of the Assad regime is working under the supervision of "Nawaf al-Bashir" to activate cells belonging to it in the region to exploit the current events.

## **An armed attack on buses transporting oil workers in the south of Deir Ezzor**



A number of workers of the Euphrates Oil Company were killed, one worker was wounded, and two others were missing, in an attack by gunmen on workers' transport buses near the Al-Taym field, south of Deir Ezzor. According to activists, three cars of the Euphrates Oil Company operating in the Al-Taym field, south of Deir Ezzor military airport, were attacked by unidentified gunmen with portable missiles, killing 9 workers, wounding two, and leaving two others missing. The media of the Assad regime accused Daesh , and said that the organization took advantage of the fog and carried out its attack on the buses.
