Oil smuggling between the Assad regime and the SDF causes pollution of the Euphrates River

Recently, large oil slicks appeared in the Euphrates River, accompanied by complaints from residents and farmers about the presence of a taste of diesel in drinking and irrigation water, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. He said that it was found that this pollution in the water is a result of the leakage of petroleum materials from the bottles, barrels and plastic pipes smuggled between the areas controlled by the SDF and the Assad regime in Deir Ezzor across the Euphrates River. A worker in the field of oil smuggling of the Fourth Division told DeirEzzor24 Network that many of the plastic containers and barrels are not sealed, and some of them are completely poured into the water when these containers are collected with ropes, floated and dragged by boats to the Division's points, which predicts an environmental disaster for the population and agricultural crops, especially vegetables. Fuel smuggling operations are widespread, between the areas controlled by the SDF and the Assad regime in Deir Ezzor, on a large scale, especially after the fuel crisis ravaging the areas controlled by the Assad regime in Deir Ezzor and Syria in general.

the engineering team of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps has begun a sweeping and demining campaign in the area surrounding the development building in the Harabish neighborhood of Deir Ezzor city, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. He said that the IRGC militia intends to hand over the building to the Directorate of Agriculture in the city of Deir Ezzor, after the latter demanded it. The militia seized the aforementioned headquarters since the end of 2017 and handed it over to the Fatemiyoun militia, which turned it into a center for manufacturing ammunition and missile platforms and prevented the Syrians from approaching it



IRGC commanders check their military and reconnaissance positions in Al-Bukamal

The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia closed the roads leading to the Al-Bukamal Bridge in the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. He mentioned that the reason for this closure was that IRGC commanders, including the so-called "Haj Hussein", "Haj Hassan" and "Abu Issa", conducted a reconnaissance tour of the military and reconnaissance points and the dungeons facing the river. He added that during their tour, the commanders withdrew elements of both Pakistani and Afghan nationalities from these points and ordered them to be sorted to other points and replaced by local elements. The commanders of the IRGC have recently intensified their tours of its points and locations throughout Deir Ezzor

A private source told DeirEzzor24 Network that the commander of the National Defense Militia in Deir Ezzor, "Firas al-Iraqiya," offered groups of residents east and west of Deir Ezzor to set up camps for them in the Badia, guarded by the militia. The source added that the camp will be set up to gather workers harvesting truffles from the desert, with tight guard day and night from the defense militia, in return for selling the crops to the Iraqis exclusively at the price he sets, or he will prevent the people from harvesting the crops. The truffle season in Deir Ezzor will start in the past few days, and the last season witnessed the recording of several accidents and injuries to truffle harvesting workers in Deir Ezzor, as a result of the explosion of land mines while searching for truffles



The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia sends members from Deir Ezzor to Iran

A private source told DeirEzzor24 Network that the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia has sent 12 of its fighters from Deir Ezzor province to Iran for an ideological military course. The source added that the course lasts for a full month, and it started yesterday, and most of the fighters are from Al-Bukamal and Al-Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor. He stressed that the aim of the course is to qualify them as leaders within the local militias affiliated with the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps, who converted to the Shiite sect and whose service exceeded five years. The Revolutionary Guard militia usually sends its affiliates to Iran from Deir Ezzor, after proving their loyalty to it, to prepare them as leaders to implement its project in Deir Ezzor



Deir Ezzor oil to the Lebanese Hezbollah militia!

A private source told DeirEzzor24 Network that the oil tanks coming from the SDF-controlled areas in Deir Ezzor move across the Euphrates River to the second bank of the Euphrates River to be collected in the towns of Zubari and Al-Boleel and the city of Mohassan, east of Deir Ezzor. The source added that after filling the oil tanks, they set out towards Homs governorate, accompanied by the escort vehicles operating within the Al-Qaterji group, and upon their arrival to the town of Al-Hamam in the Qusayr district of Homs governorate, the drivers of the oil tanks coming from Deir Ezzor are replaced by Lebanese drivers with the escort cars of the Hezbollah militia to enter Lebanese territory and unload their cargo. At militia sites and then returned to their drivers in the town of Hammam. The smuggling of oil from Deir Ezzor to the Lebanese Hezbollah militia in Lebanon comes at a time when the areas controlled by the Assad regime in all Syrian regions, including Deir Ezzor, are experiencing a real fuel crisis, which has led to the disruption of work in many facilities



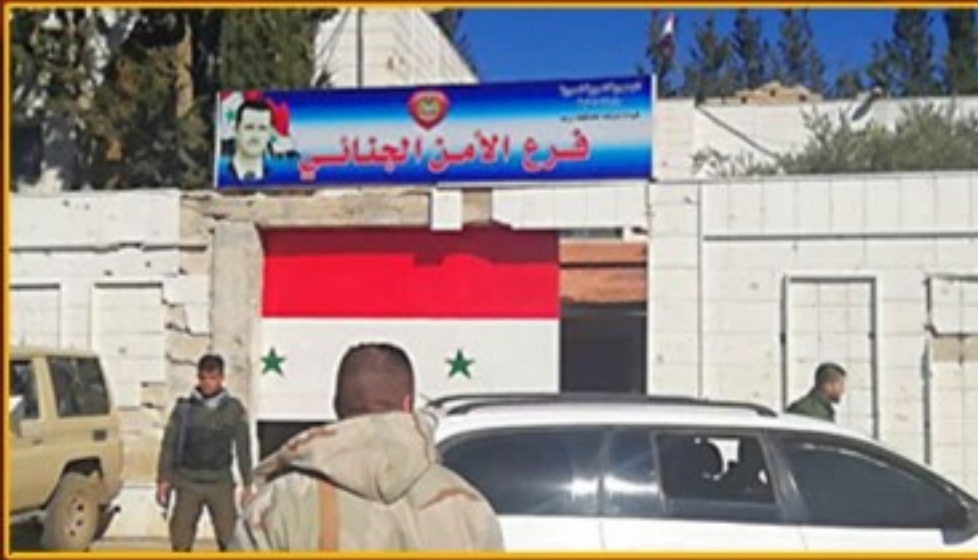
Madol Al-Aziz, president of the Fatwa club, faces punishment in Deir Ezzor

The Disciplinary and Ethics Committee decided to fine Al-Fatwa Club with three million Syrian pounds, due to its fans insulting the match referee. It also decided to suspend the president of Al-Fatwa club, "Madoul Al-Aziz", for three matches, and prevent him from accompanying the team, and consider the team a loser if he was present during the penalty period, for his disgraceful behavior in words and movement with the match referee in a way that contradicts sports ethics in general, because of his violation and storming the field at the end of the first half. . "Madoul Al-Aziz" (his nickname "Abu Al-Dabbah")enjoys Russian and Iranian support, which led him to the title of the Damascus Parliament and then to the presidency of the Al-Fatwa Club, in addition to illegal operations, including smuggling and real estate trade for the benefit of the militias

unknown warplanes targeted 4 closed trucks that had entered through the gate as part of a convoy from Iraq to the Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a private source of DeirEzzor24. Our correspondent mentioned that there were the trucks were hit by three air strikes once they arrived in the Ostora square (a truck parking lot). As a result, they were burned while the park was heavily damaged from some parts. The ice factory was partially damaged as well in addition to some commercial trucks. He added that two workers from Al-Ostora Square were injured, while the targeted truck drivers and Iranian militia members fled the scene, and no injuries were recorded among them. He confirmed that a security cordon was imposed in the vicinity of the place that lasted for several hours, during which the targeted trucks were moved to the desert and people were prevented from being around the place, and the trucks were stopped entering Syria and they retreated from the gate towards the Iraqi interior. It is noteworthy that in the morning, the Iranian militiamen, along with the security forces, collected and burned the remnants of yesterday's incident, and today there was no targeting of the aforementioned site



Theft operations have increased in Assad regime-controlled areas in Deir Ezzor

Recently, several incidents of theft were recorded, at night, from the Al-Busraya neighborhood in Deir Ezzor city, using horse-drawn carts, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. He mentioned that the recorded theft incidents are carried out by the mechanisms known locally as "Trezinas" and accompanied by three or more masked persons, who are likely to be from the military militias affiliated with Assad's forces (National Defense and Al-Quds Brigade). He added that thefts generally target shops by breaking their locks and ripping off their doors, car batteries and domestic water engines, in addition to looting uninhabited homes. Theft in areas controlled by the Assad regime in Deir Ezzor has increased to a large extent in recent times, due to the proliferation of militias, the absence of law and the deteriorating economic situation



The children of Deir Ezzor remain the main victims of the deteriorating economic conditions

The rate of beggary and child labor has risen throughout Deir Ezzor, and Albukamal in particular, to a level the province has not seen before, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. Our correspondent said that this increase in the rate of beggary and child labor came as a result of the spread of unemployment and the high prices significantly, as a large percentage of the people of the city of Al-Bukamal are forced to send their children to beg or to use them to collect and recycle garbage waste to collect their daily sustenance. Assad-held areas in Deir Ezzor are experiencing a collapsed economic situation, amid the inability of the Assad government and humanitarian organizations to protect the children of Deir Ezzor from the effects of the economic collapse in Deir Ezzor.



The price of batteries in the markets of Deir Ezzor has increased dramatically

Deir Ezzor markets in the areas controlled by the Assad regime have witnessed a significant increase in the prices of batteries of all kinds, according to the correspondent of DeirEzzor24 Network. He said that the price of gel, liquid, and other batteries has increased dramatically, due to the increase in electrical rationing hours, as it ranged from 200 to 375 thousand Syrian pounds for the small one, and 900 thousand Syrian pounds for the large 12-black battery, while the price of the 250-ampere batteries reached nearly 2 million Syrian pounds. He added that a discrepancy in prices was observed between the shops by about 50,000 pounds per piece, while the shop owners claim that the price hike is a result of the collapse of the pound's exchange rate against the dollar, the Fourth Division's checkpoints and military security royalties from battery shops. The increase in the prices of batteries was accompanied by an increase in the prices of chargers, as it ranged from 80,000 Syrian pounds for a 10-amp charger to 190,000 Syrian pounds for a 40-amp charger
