Iranian militia commanders visit a gas station northeast of Deir Ezzor

The so-called "Hajj Ahmed", the supply officer for the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, made a tour to the "Al-Mayouf" gas station in the town of Hatla, northeast of Deir Ezzor, according to a reporter of Deir Ezzor 24 He was accompanied by "Hajj Ahmed", a leader in the Syrian Hezbollah militia, "Tariq Yassin Al-Mayouf" (Abu Aqeel), for reasons that may be related to supplying the station with fuel designated for the Iranian Revolutionary Guard's vehicles. Al-Mayouf gas station is owned by the sons of "Yassin Al-Mayouf," who is the second man on the list of Shiites in Hatla and Deir Ezzor after "Hussein Al-Raja." It was restored and opened several months ago and received its allocations from the Deir Ezzor Fuel Company under smart cards and free sales.





Iranian militias in Deir Ezzor are on alert with the arrival of an Iranian leader

The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia imposed a security cordon on the Iranian square in the Al-Villat neighborhood in the city of Deir Ezzor, according to what a DeirEzzor 24 network correspondent reported. Our correspondent said that the militia has prevented the passage of residents and civilian and military vehicles since last night, after the recent raids on Iranian sites in Deir Ezzor. A private source told DeirEzzor24 that this alert coincided with the arrival of the so-called "Hajj Marouf," the health official in the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, coming from the Albukamal countryside, to inspect the militia's wounded and transfer critical cases to hospitals in the capital, Damascus. It is worth noting that the Iranian militias were on great alert due to the recent attacks by Israeli aircraft in the Albukamal countryside and the city of Deir Ez-Zor and its countryside.





Russian military police arrest two members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in Deir Ezzor

The Russian military police, along with the Military Security Detachment, arrested two members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in the Hatla al-Sharqiya neighborhood, northeast of Deir Ezzor, last night, according to what a DeirEzzor24 network correspondent reported. Our correspondent said that the two members were arrested, accompanied by a missile launcher that was prepared to target the American base near the Conoco plant northeast of Deir Ezzor. It is noteworthy that the area east of the Euphrates is under the control of the Russian First Division, represented by the Syrian Fifth Corps, and it prevents the presence of Iranian bases in the seven villages according to a previous agreement with the coalition, with the exception of civil and religious centers such as hospitals and cultural centers.





The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia intends to deploy members to Quneitra from Deir Ezzor

The leadership of the IRGC in Deir Ezzor Province informed some commanders of its intention to deploy some of its members to Quneitra province, according to a private source for the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that direct orders from Iran reached the leaders of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, coinciding with the recent Palestinian events, to transfer members from Deir Ezzor to Quneitra. The Iranian militias in Deir Ezzor have been on alert since the Israeli raids 10 days ago, followed by the recent events of the "Al-Aqsa Flood"





Iranian militias-affiliated local militiamen refuse relocation to the south of Syria

A group of local militiamen from the province of Deir Ezzor has rejected an offer by the IRGC, despite the financial advantages that come with it, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. This move by the IRGC to deploy their militiamen towards the south of Syria (Damascus and Quneitirah) coincides with the ongoing war between Israel and Hamas. The move included good salaries and other privileges for those who agreed to go.

It should be noted that there were reports of some Iranian militia commanders speaking about the deployment of manpower to support "the axis of resistance





Iranian militia commanders have fled from the Mayadeen city

A number of high-ranking Iranian militia commanders have left the city of the Mayadeen for another destination, according to a private source who told the DeirEzzor24 network today. The source said that they left the city to protect themselves from air strikes and being tacked down by what the militias call "hostile parties.' The Iranian militia leadership assigned the task of managing the headquarters and points in Deir Ezzor to members of Afghan nationality.

Because of fear of air strikes, Iranian commanders who operate in the city of Deir Ezzor are leaving their places of residence, at night, in the municipal villas neighborhood in the city of Deir Ezzor, private sources told DeirEzzor24. The sources said that Hajj Kamil, the Supreme Commander of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, has been constantly changing his residence at night for nearly a week, accompanied by his personal companion, Hajj Montazer. Senior commanders of the Iranian militias left the cities of Al-Bukamal and Al-Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor, to unknown places, about a week ago, for fear of air strikes as wel





DeirEzzor24 reveals information about the transfer of members from Iraq to Lebanon via Deir Ezzor

The Popular Mobilization Forces militia deployed new batches of members to Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, from Iraq, private sources told the DeirEzzor24 network. According to the sources, the militia has deployed about four batches so far, each batch consisting of more than 250 members who are well-equipped and armed. Among them include members of Iranian and Afghan nationalities, the majority of whom are of Iraqi nationality. They were transported to the city of Al-Mayadeen and from there to the city of Deir Ezzor and then towards Homs, via a new dirt road. They were gathered in a location near the Military College in the Al-Waer neighborhood in Homs, which had been bombed a short time ago. The Iranian militias opened the door to jihad in Homs, Latakia, and Tartous, especially for members of the Shiite sect. The Iraqi Popular Mobilization Forces militia gathered its members in Homs and sent them in groups into Lebanon in conjunction with the escalation of military operations on the Lebanese-Palestinian border





American forces announce the destruction of two drones in Syria

American forces announced the destruction of two one-way attack drones near the positions of American and coalition forces in southwestern Syria. According to an announcement by the American forces, the two drones were destroyed before they reached their intended targets, and no casualties or damage were recorded. A militia calling itself the "Iraqi Resistance" claimed responsibility for targeting the global coalition base in the Tanf area in the Syrian desert yesterday, Monday, via drones.

US fighter jets conduct new air strikes against Iran-linked sites in Syria in retaliation for attacks on US troops

US fighter jets conducted air strikes on a military site and an HQ belonging to the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia at dawn today, Friday, in Al-Humaydah area in Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, near the Syrian-Iraqi border, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. According to the reporter, no casualties were recorded in the air strikes because the Iranian militias had already evacuated a number of their headquarters in Al-Bukamal and its countryside, two hours before the raids, due to the intense drones activity in the area. He added that the HQ that was targeted was used to hold meetings and receive people coming from Iraq, and it hosted a final meeting between IRGC commanders. Four air strikes were carried out against a base for the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in the Al-Mazari area, south of the city of Al-Mayadeen, resulting in the destruction of a number of command rooms and supply rooms containing quantities of weapons, and are used as a military warehouse. The Mazari base is the largest base in Al-Mayadeen and its surroundings, and it is where the commanders of the IRGC gather sometimes. However, the air strikes did not result in casualties. In response to the U.S air strikes this early morning, the Iranian militias stationed in the vicinity of the city of Al-Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor (west of the Euphrates), bombed the global coalition base in the Omar oil field, using rockets, a shote while ago. The Pentagon claimed responsibility for the operation shortly after it was carried out, saying that American forces conducted self-defense strikes on two facilities in Al-Bukamal in eastern Syria used by Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and affiliated groups. This fresh attack by the American forces against the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in Al-Bukamal was in retaliation to a bombing that targeted the coalition base at the Conico gas plant northeast of Deir Ezzo



Russian forces found an Iranian missile base used for attacking the coalition in the east of the Euphrates

Russian military police found an Iranian missile launch base in an abandoned house in the town of Tabiya, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. According to the reporter, the base was used to target the global coalition base at the Conoco gas plant northeast of Deir Ezzor on Thursday, in addition to another site in the Al-Jubaila neighborhood in the town of Khasham. A private source told the network that the missiles were brought by members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia across the Euphrates River by boat from the town of Tabiya in Shamiya. On the other hand, the Russian militias in the region, represented by the Fifth Corps and the Russian military police, accompanied by a military security detachment, intensified search, investigation and inspection operations in the region to prevent any clash with the coalition in the areas under SDF control. The Russian police set up new points on the Euphrates River to inspect vehicles transporting personnel on the Russian bridge in the town of Al-Mariyah and the dirt bridge in the town of Al-Husseiniyah to stop the transfer of missiles to villages east of the Euphrates
