Families from Al-Ashara and Al-Quria leave their homes to avoid being used as human shields by Iranian militias

Over the past few days, the cities of Al-Ashara and Al-Quria in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor witnessed the depature of a number of families, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. According to the reporter, their departure was due to the Iranian militias' installation of field artillery and missile launchpads near their homes located on the bank of the Euphrates River opposite the SDF-controlled areas. Iranian militias deliberately set up artillery and rocket launchers between houses, to use civilians as human shields. People are fleeing their homes in the cities of Al-Ashara and Al-Quria towards the surrounding villages and towns and the city of Al-Mayadeen, due to the residents' fear that their areas would be targeted by the Coalition and the SDF if the Iranian militias targeted the American bases stationed east of the Euphrates from those populated areas.





A dispute over drugs ignites tension between two militias in eastern Deir Ezzor

A dispute arose between Abu Laith Al-Ma'ishi, the commander of Al-Baqir Brigade militia in Deir Ezzor, and the commander of the Sayyida Zainab Regiment militia in Al-Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. According to the reporter, the dispute occurred as both factions had been competing against each other over drug traficking operations in and around the city of Al-Mayadeen, and the incident escalated after Al-Baqir militia withdrew its members from the Badia region and moved them to the Mayadeen city. A number of Iranian militia commanders in the Mayadeen intervened in order to contain the dispute and calm the situation.

the Assad regime announced the killing of the commander of Al-Mukhtar armed militia, which is affiliated with Air Force Intelligence, Juma Al-Ashram and nicknamed Juma Al-Mukhtar, as a result of an injury he suffered two days ago at his headquarters on Al-Wadi Street in the city of Deir Ezzor. The Assad regime was quick to announce a "battery' explosion, two days ago, in Al-Wadi neighborhood, which led to the injury of four people, whose identities were not specified. Private sources confirmed to the DeirEzzor24 network that the explosion was not the result of a battery, but rather an explosive device prepared for remote detonation, which exploded in the "ashram" headquarters only 5 minutes after he entered it, which led to his serious injury along with 3 members, after which they were taken to the hospital. According to the sources, the Russians are behind the targeting of the "ashram," as the ashram opposed Russian forces' orders, some time ago, to arrest members of the "Wagner' militia. The officers added that the Assad regime's Air Force Intelligence arrested a number of members of the ashram to investigate the circumstances of the case, and Russian forces are trying to get them out. Russian forces honored the "ashram' last year, due to the military services it provided to the Assad regime. It is noteworthy that "Juma Al-Ashram", the leader of the "Al-Mukhtar" militia, which consists of 6 groups that operates ostensibly under the umbrella of Air Force Intelligence, and implements the orders of the Russian forces in practice, has a large record in drug trafficking, imposing royalties, and recruiting people with a history of special missions for the benefit of Air Force Intelligence or Russian forces



Members of the Popular Mobilization Forces militia secretly enter Deir Ezzor

More than 50 members of the Iraqi Popular Mobilization Forces militia entered Syria through the Sakak crossing and Al-Bukamal crossing from Iraq, under the protection of cars belonging to the Iranian Security Office in the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, a private source told the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that the elements took a desert road to reach Al-Ward Field, east of Deir Ezzor, and then took a military side road leading from Al-Ward Field to the city of Deir Ezzor, and avoided entering the city of Al-Bukamal. Members took the Deir Ezzor-Palmyra road without knowing their true destination, and it is likely that their destination was the southern border areas





Iranian militias offer notables a number of privileges in return for the recruitment of their sons

Iranian militia commanders and a number of officers from the security branches in Deir Ezzor held separate meetings with a number of notables from the city of Al-Bukamal and its countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a DeirEzzor24 network reporter. According to the reporter, the commanders of the Iranian militias offered to the tribal notables to help them recruit their sons into their ranks, in exchange for many privileges, including facilitating their trade, especially in drugs, and facilitating the smuggling operations that a number of them supervise between Syria and Iraq. The Iranian militias in Deir Ezzor are seeking to recruit the largest number of elements to compensate for the elements they sent to the southern regions of Syria





Iranian militias grow "hashish" in Deir Ezzor

Private sources revealed to the DeirEzzor24 network private information stating that Iranian militias grow the narcotic "hashish' in Deir Ezzor. The sources said that the commander of the Abu al-Fadl al-Abbas militia is considered primarily responsible for cultivating the narcotic substance "hashish" in the desert of the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor. They added that the cultivation of "hashish" by Iranian militias is concentrated in the Al-Mayadeen desert, south of Al-Rahba Castle, where it is grown among barley crops, and its cultivation has also spread in the desert of Al-Duwair and Salihiyat Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, in the same previous way. The Iranian militias attach great importance to cannabis cultivation, and it is considered one of the most important sources of funding for them in Deir Ezzor





Iranian militias install rocket launchers in Al-Mayadeen city amidst a state of high alert

Members of the Abu al-Fadl al-Abbas militia are deployed with full equipment in the city of Al-Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. According to the reporter, the militia conducted patrols consisting of military vehicles (pick-ups) mounted with anti-aircraft guns, adding that this deployment coincides with the Iranian militias' installation of rocket launchers and field artillery, among civilian homes near the electricity company, next to Al-Qalaa Ice Factory in the city of Al-Mayadeen. The city is witnessing extreme tension, amid the alert among the ranks of the Iranian militias in the city, as a result of the air strikes that targeted several militia sites in the city of Deir Ezzor last night.





DeirEzzor24 reveals the location of a drug laboratory for the Revolutionary Guard militia in Deir Ezzor

DeirEzzor24 Network learned from private sources the existence of a secret laboratory for narcotic substances under the supervision of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in the city of Deir Ezzor. The sources said that this factory is located in its Iranian kitchen building in the Rusafa neighborhood of the city, and its operations are camouflaged by cooking operations, while narcotic substances are produced in it. The kitchen is a primitive laboratory for manufacturing narcotic pills, and work began in it approximately more than a year ago, while the kitchen continues to operate for the purpose of camouflaging it.

US fighter jets conduct precision strikes against IRGC safehouses in Al-Bukamal and Al-Mayadln in eastern Syria, & Iranian militias respond by land

The US Department of Defense announced through a written statement that US forces carried out strikes yesterday against facilities used by the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia and other Iranian militias in eastern Syria, as a response to a group of ongoing attacks against US forces in Iraq and Syria. It confirmed that the strikes targeted a training facility and a safe house near the cities of Al-Mayadeen and Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor. A reporter of DeirEzzor24 said that one of the strikes targeted positions of the Hezbollah militia in the "Haidariya' area, while another targeted points of the Popular Mobilization Forces militia on the Syrian-Iraqi border, and a raid against the headquarters of the Zainabiyoun militia near the Al-Bukamal Bridge, leaving dead and wounded among their ranks. For its part, the Iranian militias targeted the coalition base in the "Conoco Gas Plant' northeast of Deir Ezzor, with shells and rockets, which led to the coalition's alert, after midnight last night, in response to the American raids. Our reporter also said that a number of shells and missiles fell in the vicinity of the base, and another number fell on civilian homes in the town of Al-Izbah, north of Deir Ezzor. He added that other shells fell in the area of the ancient al-Sin hill, adjacent to the town of Marat, which is under the control of Assad's forces, at seven o'clock on Monday morning, coming from the west of the Euphrates River and close to the points of the Russian Fifth Corps. It is worth noting that the coalition strikes left at least 6 dead and a large number of wounded from Iranian militias in Al-Bukamal.



A secret meeting between a Russian official and an Iranian official in the city of Deir Ezzor


A short meeting brought together the Russian General "Vladimir" and the so-called "Hajj Rasoul", the official of the Iranian Cultural Center in Deir Ezzor, at the rest house of "Hajj Fadel" in the Al-Qusour neighborhood in the city of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. The source said that the meeting was strictly secret, and its reason or content was not known, and a tight security cordon was placed around the meeting place. The Russians prevented both "Hajj Rasoul" and "Hajj Deeb", officials of the Iranian Cultural Center, from entering the town of Hatla, a few days ago, against the backdrop of members of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia targeting coalition bases in the SDF-controlled areas (east of the Euphrates)





The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia relocate weapons depots from the Al-Bukamal countryside

The commander of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in the city of Al-Bukamal, Hajj Amir Abbas, issued direct instructions to local and Iraqi militia commanders, according to what was reported by a DeirEzzor24 network local reporter. According to the reporter, the instructions included the necessity of relocating weapons and rockets depots from the village of Al-Hari, near the Iraqi-Syrian border in the Al-Bukamal countryside, to several locations far from the border. He added that the Iranian militias immediately began implementing the orders, as they transferred a portion of the military equipment stock to the city, while a portion of rocket shipments was transferred to the safehouses in the Green Belt area via military vehicles belonging to the 17th Division. Those who were in charge of the relocation of weapons and rockets from the village of Al-Hari were members of foreign nationalities affiliated with the Afghan Fatemiyoun militia.

The Syrian boy, "Asid al -Abd al -Kahla", who comes from Al -Qouriya, has achieved a local heavyweight championship in the North-Rhine Province, after defeating a Russian boxer of six and a half years older than him. In a special interview with Deir Ezzor 24 Mr. Jassim Al -Akla, the father of the hero, said: My son Asid achieved the local boxing championship, which is held in the city of Nümbrecht in North Rhine Province, after defeating the Russian boxer Joel Abramsem at the age of 23, in heavy weight 95 kg. He added: "My son Asid plays heavy weight in boxing, although he did not exceed fifteen years only a few months, but his physical structure qualifies him for that, as he weighs 95 kg and has long stature." The hero "Assaid" descends from the city of Al -Quriyah, east of Deir Ezzor, who resorted to his family to Germany with refugee convoys several years ago, and since then decided to professionalize the sport that I love "boxing" and has achieved many local championships so far at the level of Germany





The Russians are intensifying their measures in Deir Ezzor to curb Iranian militias

The Fifth Corps of the Russian forces established new points on the Euphrates River in the seven villages with the aim of preventing the arrival of boats carrying Iranian missiles that are targeting the coalition base in the Conoco field, according to a DeirEzzor24 network correspondent. Our local reporter said hat this action by the Russian forces comes within a set of measures taken by the Russians to prevent the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia from using the countryside north of the river as a base to target the coalition, which included changing the guard detachments on the dirt bridge and the floating metal bridge, and intensifying military security patrols in the seven villages. And planting some river mines on the bank of the Euphrates, east of the town of Tabiya Jazira, and activating the role of mukhtars within the villages as their eyes in the region. A Russian-American agreement was concluded three years ago to evacuate these villages from Iranian military bases and place them under Russian control onl
