Iranian militias arrest two of their members in Al-Bukamal on charges of treason

The security office of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia arrested two members of the 47th Regiment militia in Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, yesterday, a local private source told the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that the two members were arrested on charges of communicating with commanders present in Al-Tanf area. The two members were taken to the security prison of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia to complete their investigation



Dozens of Iranian militia members flee from Deir Ezzor due to American strikes

The sources said that the majority of the fleeing members belong to militias who operate in the town of Ayyash, west of Deir Ezzor, and Al-Rahba guards and the Iranian Kitchen in Port Said, Al-Mayadeen, and Al-Bukamal, for fear of renewed American bombing on Iranian militia sites. before The Iranian militias evacuated their positions of foreign members and leaders before the American strikes on their positions in Deir Ezzor, and kept the local members.



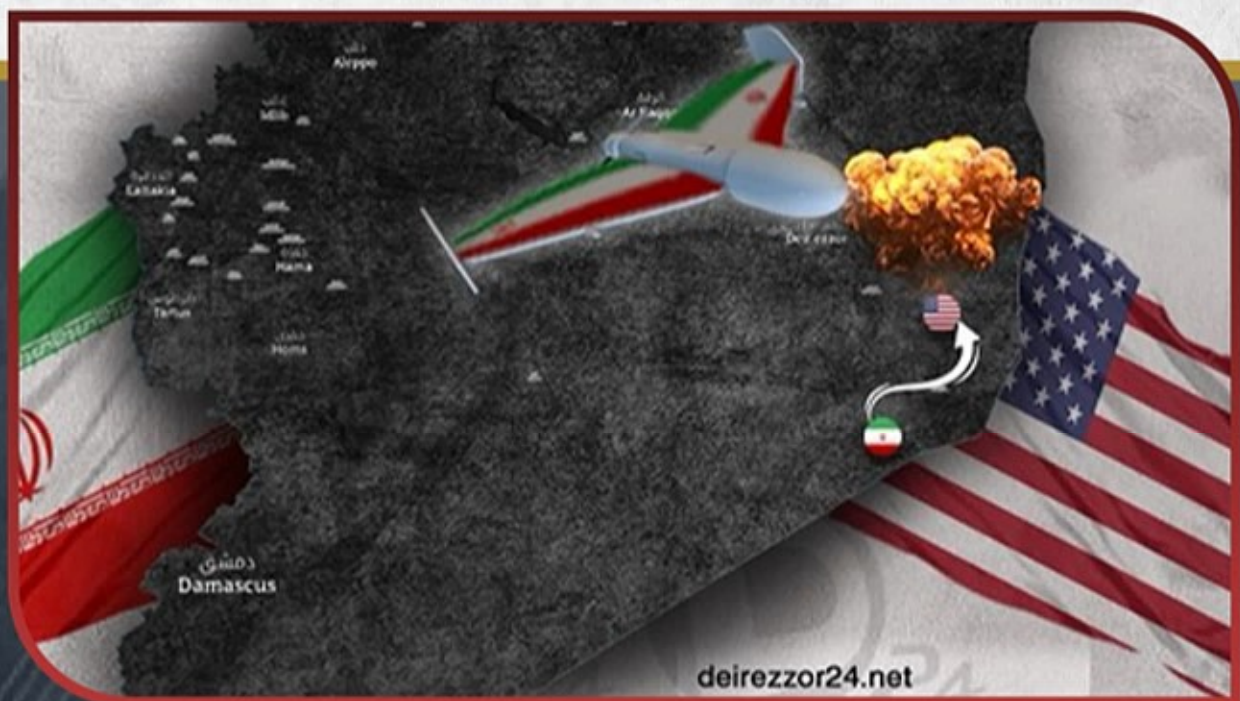
Iranian militias receive a shipment of heavy weapons and drones in the eastern Deir Ezzor countryside

Military and logistical reinforcements of the Afghan Fatemiyoun Brigade militia arrived in the city of Subikhan in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor yesterday, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. According to the reporter, five Toyota Shas pickup trucks arrived yesterday at the water filtration station on the shore of the Euphrates River in the city of Subikhan. He added that the cars were loaded with short-range Katyusha and Grad missiles BM-21, as well as drones. The shipment was accompanied by members of the Lebanese Hezbollah militia and the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia



Casualties reported in an attack by Iranian militias on a global coalition base in Deir Ezzor

the SDF announced that 6 of its members were killed in a suicide drone attack that targeted the global coalition base in the Al-Omar oil field in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor, at midnight last night. The SDF said in a statement published this morning that 6 of its members were killed during a terrorist attack by a suicide drone coming from areas controlled by "Syrian regime mercenaries", which targeted a training academy in Al-Omar field, east of Deir Ezzor. The SDF added, "While we condemn this terrorist attack, we affirm our right to an appropriate military response to the source of the attack." Deir Ezzor network local reporters had monitored an explosion at the base of the Al-Omar oil field last night, the source of which was unknown. The attack on the coalition base in Al-Omar field yesterday was similar to the attack on its base in Al-Tanf on the twenty-eighth of last month, with a suicide drone, which led to the death of 3 American personnel and the injury of 25



A violent clash breaks out between two families in Al-Bukamal countryside

An armed clash broke out between the Hussein Al-Ali family and Al-Satam family in the village of Al-Hari in Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, this morning, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. According to the reporter, the clash was caused by an old quarrel between the two families, renewed today, and left injuries on both sides, one of whom was identified as Abdullah bin Hussein Al-Ali, and his condition was serious. He was taken to a hospital in Deir Ezzor. He added that the clashes were violent to the extent that the two sides resorted to using mortar shells, and large security forces went out to the town to try to calm the situation. Hussein Al-Ali is one of the biggest collaborators with the Iranian militias in the Albukamal countryside, and the Hezbollah militia had previously intervened in the issue of revenge between his family and the "Al-Satam" family



Iranian militias are monopolizing truffles in Al-Bukamal

Iranian militias in the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor prevented truffle collectors from heading to Al-Bukamal desert to search for truffle, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. Our reporter said that the militias prevented civilians from going out to collect truffles under the pretext of the existence of Daesh cells in Al-Bukamal desert, noting that the main reason for the ban is the existence of Iranian militia sites in the desert on the one hand, and the desire of the elements to be alone in collecting and trading truffles, with the price of a kilogram exceeding 600 thousand Syrian pounds. It should be pointed out that the Iranian militias and Assad's forces seek to monopolize the collection and trade of truffles in Deir Ezzor, with their prices rising locally and abroad



A private source for DeirEzzor24: Al-Afees was not arrested and is still on the run

A private source told the DeirEzzor24 network that Fadi Al-Afees was not arrested in the “paper factory” case as was reported two days ago, as he managed to disappear and has been out of sight ever since. The source added that four officers from the Republican Guard were arrested for participating in stealing the contents of the paper mill in the town of Al-Husseiniyah, west of Deir Ezzor, and cutting the mill’s iron into two trucks, one of which was confiscated. It was prepared for sale to the Fourth Division, while others confirmed that the iron was transported to the iron smelting plant in the Mu’izila area, which is under SDF control.



The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia deploys new elements from Iraq to Deir Ezzor province

This morning, the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia deployed a batch of its members from Iraqi territory to the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. Our reporter said that two buses entered from Iraqi territory heading towards Al-Bukamal, crossing the border from the direction of the railway crossing, which is under the control of the Iraqi Popular Mobilization Forces militia, and they were accompanied by two four-wheel drive vehicles. It is noteworthy that the buses of the officers passed from the town of Al-Hari towards the city of Al-Bukamal, and dropped the elements, whose number is estimated at about 50, in the security associations square in the city



The railway crossing in Al-Bukamal countryside will be stopped for this reason

The leader of the Iraqi Hezbollah militia, Hajj Ahmed, issued a decision to evacuate Al-Sakak crossing (the Iranian-backed militia crossing) in Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of DeirEzzor24. Our reporter said that all entry and exit operations of smuggling trucks through the crossing were halted following the decision. He added that Haj Ahmed's decision came due to the continuous intense flights of drones over the Syrian-Iraqi border. Haj Ahmed is a leader in the Iraqi Hezbollah militia, an Iraqi national, and responsible for smuggling operations at the gate. The Iranian-backed militias have recently intensified the entry of large quantities of weapons from Iraq into Syria using that crossing, in addition to other secret crossings on the Syrian-Iraqi border



Serious dispute arises between Iranian-backed militia commanders over recent US strikes

A private source told the DeirEzzor24 Network that the commanders of the Fatemiyoun militia expressed their anger at some Iranian-backed militia commanders in Deir Ezzor, after the recent American strikes on its positions in Deir Ezzor. The source added that a heated meeting, which was about the USA strikes on Iranian militias' positions in Deir Ezzor province, was held in the house of Haj Fadel's house in the Qosor neighborhood in Deir Ezzor city, which included Hajj Kamil, the commander-in-chief of the IRGC militia in Deir Ezzor, Abu Zainab al-Afghani, the commander of the Fatemiyoun militia, as well as a third security official whose identity was anonymous. He pointed out that the commanders of the Fatemiyoun militia were angry and felt betrayed because they were not informed of the date of the US strikes, like the rest of the militias in Deir Ezzor, noting that the strikes eliminated more than 30 people, most of whom were elements belonging to the Fatemiyoun militia in the town of Ayyash, west of Deir Ezzor, including military commanders. An hour before the US strikes occurred, the Iranian militias had already evacuated most of their positions in Deir Ezzor. However, they kept some local members stationed in some headquarters and did not inform the Fatimiyun militia of the timing of the strikes, given the sensitive position ("guarding weapons and ammunition depots") it occupies in the town of Ayyash.



Iranian communications experts arrive in Deir Ezzor on a special mission

The Iranian-backed militias brought in four communications experts of Iranian nationality recently, a private source told the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that the experts crossed from Iraq into Syria using Al-Qaim crossing. They headed to the city of Al-Bukamal 3 days ago, after which they moved to Deir Ezzor city. They have been installing new and advanced communications and surveillance devices for the Iranian militias near the signal battalion. The source confirmed that the Iranian-backed militias in Deir Ezzor allocated special housing near the battalion for the experts. The militias want to tighten control over internal communications and carry out cyber attacks against targets east of the Euphrates. It should be pointed out that two advanced communications systems belonging to the Iranian-backed militias were destroyed by the recent American strikes in Deir Ezzor, the first on the mountain overlooking the Harabesh neighborhood in the city of Deir Ezzor, and the second in the vicinity of Al Rahba Castle in the city of Al Mayadeen
