The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia plans to establish a new camp in eastern Deir Ezzor

Private sources have informed the DeirEzzor24 network recently that the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia is planning to establish a new training camp in Deir Ezzor. The sources added that the militia tasked one of its security committees with searching for a key area for the training camp. Among the most important places chosen by the committee was the location behind the Ain Ali shrine in the Al-Quria desert, as it is a good location to protect the shrine from attacks coming from the desert, secure it for visitors, and keep elements away from the cities of Al-Mayadeen and Al-Ashara. The militia announced that it would start establishing barricades and berms around the place, install prefabricated rooms, and dig an underground warehouse where the militia would store its weapons temporarily as a means to avoid air strikes. It should be pointed out that the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia began assembling the necessary machinery to dig at the farm headquarters, to transport it to the location of the new camp in the Quriyeh desert



Iranian-backed militia commanders and reinforcements arrive in Deir Ezzor

Military reinforcements belonging to the Iraqi Popular Mobilization Forces militia arrived at the Iranian security square in the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, yesterday, according to a private source that told the DeirEzzor24 network. Our reporter said that the arrival of reinforcements coincided with the arrival of a number of Iranian-backed militia commanders to the city of Al-Bukamal, and they entered Syrian territory through the illegal Iranian crossing (Al-Sakk crossing), located in the border village of Al-Hari. He added that their number is estimated at 8 people, and they went to the city of Al-Mayadeen and conducted a tour of Al-Rahba Castle and the shrine of Ain Ali in the Al-Quria desert and the surrounding area, and in the Al-Haidariyah area in the Al-Mayadeen desert today. It is worth noting that, for the second day in a row, commanders from Iranian-backed militias enter Deir Ezzor in eastern Syria, coming from Iraq



The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia prepares a secret prison in Al-Bukamal

The DeirEzzor24 Network learned from private sources that the security office of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia is preparing its own secret prison in the Katef neighborhood in the city of Al-Bukamal, east of Deir Ezzor. According to the sources, Hajj Muhammad, the prison official in the security office, was the one who ordered the preparation of the prison, and a house (basement) in the Al-Katf neighborhood, which is completely controlled by the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, was chosen as the location for the prison, to be close to the security headquarters located in the same neighborhood. In order to facilitate its protection and prevent people from knowing its location. It is noteworthy that the Iranian-backed militias have greatly activated their security office in Deir Ezzor recently, especially after the recent escalation with the international coalition in the region



Truffle collection has become a risky activity with the presence of regime-aligned militias in Deir Ezzor

On days like these every year for the past five years, Deir Ezzor province loses dozens of its people harvesting truffles as a result of mines and deliberate killings that do not distinguish between a man, a woman, and a child. The most recent of these incidents occurred yesterday in the Kabajib desert, southwest of Deir Ezzor, where two people were killed and 12 cars transporting workers and their belongings were burned, in exchange for an amount of 200,000 per person. Despite the warnings that accompany this work, some people, especially members of the "Al-Busaraya" clan who live in the western countryside of Deir Ezzor, see the truffle season as an opportunity to make a profit for themselves by collecting truffles whose price ranges between 250 and 500 thousand Syrian pounds per kilo. The "Shamiya" region, or west of the Euphrates, which extends from Al-Bishri in the west towards the Badia in the east, is known to be one of the richest areas for truffles in Syria. It is also known for the density of its military checkpoints. However, the region is geographically divided between the Afghan Fatemiyoun militia, and the Al-Quds Brigade militia led by the Cameroonian. There are many minefields and no one is allowed to search for mushrooms except under the supervision of each of them using a lump-sum fee method, while the crop goes to the militia. While the Assad regime, which is unable to protect the people whose livelihood forces them to do this work, says that these attacks are terrorist acts carried out by Daesh, and promotes its presence in the region for political goals. The people of Deir Ezzor exchange talk about the Fatemiyoun militias, the Al Quds Liwa, and the military security affiliated with Assad's forces, that all acts of killing, kidnapping, stealing, and slaughtering livestock are their work, and they confirm that there is coordination between those militias and ISIS, which has a partnership in these crimes committed against the people of Deir Ezzor.



Iranian-backed militias uncover the grave of Imam Ali in the Al-Bukamal countryside

The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia began expanding and reconstructing a grave in the village of Al-Suwayyah in the Al-Bukamal countryside in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor, according to a DeirEzzor24 network reporter. Our reporter said that the Iranian-backed militias claim that this grave belongs to Imam Ali, and officials from the Jihad al-Binaa organization and leaders from the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia met to plan the matter. It is worth noting that the Iranian-backed militias have controlled this place since they entered Al-Bukamal in 2017, and military commanders visit it and civilians are not allowed to approach it.



Iranian-backed militias rehabilitate an air field in Deir Ezzor

The Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia is seeking to rehabilitate and operate Al-Hamdan Agricultural Airport in Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. Our reporter said that the Revolutionary Guard militia is seeking to use Al-Hamdan Airport as a helicopter landing pad and a strategic military zone, through the Jihad Al-Binaa Association. He added that an engineering delegation including Iranian and Syrian engineers visited the city of Al-Bukamal, in company with IRGC security this afternoon, to view the airport site and study the steps for its reconstruction. Al-Hamdan Airport is located near the military headquarters of the Afghan Fatemiyoun militia, and the latter will be entrusted with the task of protecting the airport later, but the current fears of the militias are the possibility of repeated American strikes.



Two IRGC militiamen are involved in the murder of a 30-year-old girl in Deir Ezzor

The DeirEzzor24 network managed to obtain more details about the murder of a young woman in her thirties in the city of Deir Ezzor, even though the regime and its militias tried to conceal the background of the criminals. After the killing of Mrs. "Reem" in Al-Jubaila neighborhood in the city of Deir Ezzor about a week ago, and her body was thrown in a waste container, wrapped in a Red Crescent blanket, before the Christian Park and near the party preparation school, DeirEzzor24 started inquiring about the crime and arrived at the following facts First, the girl was murdered as the criminals were attempting to steal heavy gold jewelry. 75 grams. Second, two IRGC militia members participated in the crime. They were the ones who kidnapped Reem, and they operate in the Maizila area south of the town of Salhiya in Al-Bukamal countryside. One of them is called (Uday) from the town of Khasham and he was arrested, while the second person fled to SDF-controlled areas. His parents were arrested in the Criminal Security Branch and are under investigation pending his surrender. The Assad regime blacked out the details of the crime in the media and did not address the identity and work of the perpetrators. It is noteworthy that most of the weapons and murder crimes in the areas controlled by the Assad regime in Deir Ezzor bear the fingerprints of armed militias, including the National Defense Forces, the Al-Quds Brigade, and the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia.



Details; A New Series of US Strikes Hit

Positions of Iran-Backed Militias In Deir Ezzor

US fighter jets carried out a series of strikes, targeting military and security HQs that belong to the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in Deir Ezzor, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. According to our reporter, a strike hit a villa used by the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in the villa area opposite the administration of Al-Furat University in the city of Deir Ezzor, resulting in its total destruction. On the other hand, another strike hit the communication tower in the Maqabir (graves) area, located on the mountain overlooking Deir Ezzor city, resulting in the death of five fighters from Iranian militias. Our reporter added that the jets also bombed Iranian militia sites in the farm area in the city of Al-Mayadin, east of Deir Ezzor, and the headquarters of Unit 313 of the Hezbollah militia, inflicting casualties upon the militias over there. Furthermore, air strikes were carried out against the Ayyash military warehouses, which belong to the Iranian-backed militias in the town of Ayyash, west of Deir Ezzor. Concerning Al-Bukmal area in the far east of the province, strikes hit the headquarters of the IRGC Security Office near the Sharia Mosque in the city, and another militia headquarters (the Badr Hospital headquarters) near Alhajanah Street, which was hosting a security meeting between commanders from the IRGC, headed by Hajj Askar, with the commanders of the military axes, in preparation for maneuvers in Al-Bukamal desert. A private source had told the DeirEzzor24 network that the air strikes resulted in the serious injury of the IRGC commander Haj Askar, who has been transferred to the Iranian hospital in Al-Sukariyah village for treatment. On the other hand, the commander of the Hezbollah militia, known as Haj Hassan, was moderately injured along with the head of the Iranian security office in Al-Bukamal, Haj Jahid. A number of members and guards who operate at the HQs were killed.

The names of commanders and members of Iran-backed militias who were killed in Deir Ezzor last night

The DeirEzzor24 network documented the names of those killed and injured in the air strikes that targeted sites and headquarters of Iranian-backed militias in Deir Ezzor, after midnight last Monday. A DeirEzzor24 network reporter said that the names of those killed when the "Badr Hospital" headquarters were targeted in the city of Al-ukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, are as follows: Ali Al-Hamwi, Muhammad Abdo, Ali Jaafar, Ammar Salmiya, and two unidentified bodies. After the strike, Haj Askar, commander of the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia, was reported seriously injured, Haj Hassan, the Hezbollah militia official in the region, was also wounded. Haj Jahid, the head of the Iranian Security Bureau, was lightly injured. The strikes also led to the death of two members of Iraqi nationality. In the city of Deir Ezzor, the following were killed: Akram al-Muhammad, Hussein Adra, and a person nicknamed Abu Wissam. The strikes hit the Iranian security office in the Al-Qusour neighborhood, resulting in the injury of several members while the targeted building was completely damaged. In the city of Al-Mayadeen, 3 members were killed in a raid targeting the farmer's headquarters, all of them from Homs, whose names are unknown. Today, Iranian agencies announced the killing of a leader in the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia named Behrouz Vahidi, and one of the Iranian Revolutionary Guards' advisors, in the American strikes on Deir Ezzor.
