Russian forces strengthen their presence in Deir Ezzor by recruiting a new brigade

DeirEzzor24 Network learned from private sources that the Fifth Corps of the Russian First Division supported its forces in Deir Ezzor Governorate. The sources said that the Corps rearranged its ranks and brought the Seventh Brigade to Deir Ezzor and organized the positioning of the Fifth and Sixth Brigades according to the following order. The Fifth Brigade includes four infantry battalions, the first in the town of Tabiya Jazira, the second in the towns of Khasham, Mazloum, and Marat northeast of Deir Ezzor, the third in the town of Hatla (the barracks of the Russian Reconciliation Center), and the fourth at Deir Ezzor Military Airport, in addition to the engineering, mortar, and radar company. The Sixth Brigade is deployed in the Al-Mayadeen area and includes four battalions, including a tank and artillery battalion. The Seventh Brigade, which was recently recruited, occupies points that were in the duties of the Fifth and Sixth Brigade in each of the Al-Taym, Al-Shula and Kabajib fields on the Deir ez-Zor-Damascus road. Added to the Corps are the command's guard companies at the Narcotics Branch Center in the college cluster on Panorama Road and the Suburb Villas neighborhood, and the Russian Military Police. The strength of each battalion in the Fifth Corps is approximately 150 members, the majority of whom are local volunteers within the ranks of the Fifth Assault Corps, so that the numerical staff of the Corps within Deir Ezzor Governorate is approximately 2,400, including officers and non-commissioned officers detached from other Assad forces divisions.

a closed truck with a number of pick-up vehicles for guarding entered from the military gate in the town of Al-Hari in the Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, to Al-Bukamal coming from Iraq, according to a DeirEzzor24 network local reporter. Our reporter said that upon its entry, patrols belonging to the Revolutionary Guard militia deployed in a number of streets in the city of Albukamal, and headed directly to the Al-Jami'at neighborhood. According to a special source for DeirEzzor24, the truck carried short-range missiles and was unloaded at a warehouse belonging to the Revolutionary Guard militia in the Al-Jami'at neighborhood. From time to time, Iran sends arms shipments to the militias it supports in Deir Ezzor via Iraq



Large numbers of Deir Ezzor residents withdraw from pilgrimage registration for this reason!

DeirEzzor24 network local reporter said that approximately one-third of those registered to perform the Hajj (pilgrimage) from Deir Ezzor province withdrew after the financial cost of performing the Hajj was issued by the Assad regime. He added that the cost of Hajj, which was approved by the Assad regime, amounted to 5,000 US dollars, which is equivalent to approximately 75 million Syrian pounds, of which 2,000 dollars is paid to the Ministry of Endowments, in addition to the amounts that the pilgrim needs for his own purposes and gifts. The cost was not expected and surprised the Syrians because of the blackmail and financial slander in the name of religion for the benefit of the Ministry of Endowments, noting that expectations were not more than \$3,000 in light of the difficult living conditions and the inability of most people to perform Hajj this year



A commander in the Revolutionary Guard militia dies under mysterious circumstances in Al-Mayadin city

DeirEzzor24 Network learned from private sources of the death of the commander of the Zainabiyoun company in the city of Al-Mayadin, east of Deir Ezzor, about a week ago under mysterious circumstances. According to the sources, Kazem Hakim Naeem Al-Salhi, an Iraqi national, and commander of the "Zainabiyoun" company, died in the city of Al-Mayadin, and the cause of his death was not known, and the Revolutionary Guard militia concealed his death. They added that the news circulating about his death indicates two statements: the first is that he died as a result of poison that was found in his food, and the second is that he died as a result of taking a large dose of narcotic pills. It is noteworthy that the Revolutionary Guard militia transported his body secretly to his hometown in Iraq and was buried there



Senior Revolutionary Guard commander leaves Syria for Iran for treatment

A private source told the DeirEzzor24 network today that Hajj Askar, the second man in the Revolutionary Guard militia and the commander of Al-Mayadeen and Al-Bukamal sectors, left Syrian territory towards Tehran for the purpose of treatment. The source continued that Askar sustained an injury in the last American air strike against Iranian militias, with shrapnel in the thigh and another that was discovered in the abdomen, and he assigned Hajj Maxim, the official in charge of graduating courses in the Revolutionary Guard militia, to carry out his duties until he returns from the treatment trip. It is noteworthy that Hajj Aska left Al-Bukamal for Damascus shortly after the last strike on Al-bukamal more than a month ago, heading to Damascus to receive treatment, then leaving for Tehran to complete it.



As Eid al-Adha approaches, Hezbollah militia smuggles Deir Ezzor livestock into Iraq

DeirEzzor24 Network learned from private sources that the Iraqi Hezbollah militia smuggled large quantities of sheep, cows and camels from Albukamal and Deir Ezzor in general to Iraq in recent days. The sources said that the militia smuggled herds of livestock into Iraq through the smuggling gate (the military gate in Al-Hari) due to the proximity of Eid Al-Adha, and Iraqi merchants affiliated with the militia bought them. She added that the militia buys livestock from the people of Deir Ez-Zor through persuasion and intimidation, and the person responsible for smuggling them is called "Abu Fatima," affiliated with the Iraqi Hezbollah militia. He employs brokers and merchants who buy livestock for him from the cities and transport them to the town of Al-Hari in the Albukamal countryside to be smuggled into Iraq. It is worth noting that the so-called "Abu Fatima" and his brokers have papers from the Revolutionary Guard militia that allow them to pass through the Assad forces' checkpoints without stopping them or taking a ticket from their cars



Who are the "Imam Ali bin Abi Talib" brigades that operate in Al-Bukamal?

A private source revealed to the Deir Ezzor 24 network the details of a militia affiliated with the Revolutionary Guard militia in Albukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, called the "Imam Ali bin Abi Talib Brigades." The source said that the militia operates four axes 45 km south of the city of Albukamal, deep in the desert, on the line of contact, with the deployment of the Iraqi Mobilization Forces militia. He added that the number of the militia is approximately 400 members, and their groups receive special treatment from the leadership of the Revolutionary Guard militia, and they receive the same salaries as the members of the other militias (2 million liras per month). The militia is led by an Iranian military commander nicknamed (Haj Hussein), and the militia occupies an air defense position in the Guard militia. The revolutionary. It is noteworthy that most of the members of the "Imam Ali bin Abi Talib Brigades" militia are from the towns of Al-Foua and Kafriya in the Idlib countryside

trucks (tankers) loaded with narcotic drugs entered the Revolutionary Guard militia across the Iraqi border through the railway crossing in Albukamal towards the city of Deir Ezzor, according to what was reported by the DeirEzzor24 network correspondent. Our correspondent said that the tankers and their cargo remained stationed in the "Panorama" area at the southern entrance to the city of Deir Ezzor, accompanied by a guard of Iranian-backed militia members, and then set off towards Hawija Sukr, which is one of the most prominent militia strongholds in the region. It is noteworthy that this is one of the few times that Iranian-backed militias smuggle narcotic substances from Iraq to Syria, as the drug production line, as is known, begins with the Hezbollah militia in Lebanon and some of its headquarters in Syria

The Revolutionary Guard militia held a funeral for the killing of the Iranian president and his accompanying delegation, at the Iranian Cultural Center in the city of Deir Ezzor, reported by a DeirEzzor24 local reporter. Our reporter said that at the top of the list of recipients of condolences was "Hajj Askar," one of the most prominent leaders of the Revolutionary Guard militia in Al-Bukamal, who returned from health leave in Tehran two days ago. He added that groups of tribal sheikhs and notables loyal to the Assad regime came to the funeral council to offer condolences. It is noteworthy that most of the Iranian leaders in the militias in Deir Ezzor went to Damascus to attend the funeral held in the hall of the Iranian embassy in Damascus.



Deir Ezzor farmers refrain from selling wheat to the Self-Rule Administration

A DeirEzzor24 network reporter said that most of the wheat trucks stopped delivering their cargo to a center 10 km north of Deir Ezzor. Our reporter added that the reluctance of wheat owners to supply to the SDF came after its price was issued by the Autonomous Administration, a difference of 12 cents from last year's price and 24 cents from the year 2022. Activists and farmers from the region called for a boycott of the delivery of the wheat crop to the Autonomous Administration, organizing anti-SDF demonstrations, and withdrawing the price of wheat this year.
