SDF confiscates a shipment of wheat prepared for smuggling to areas controlled by the Assad regime in Deir Ezzor

The SDF confiscated two "Inter" trucks loaded with wheat that were heading towards Assad regime-controlled areas from the Zaghir Jazira town crossing in the western countryside of Deir Ezzor, according to a DeirEzzor24 network correspondent. Our correspondent said that the SDF stopped a number of trucks at river crossings loaded with wheat in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor. He pointed out that the SDF's goal in cutting off wheat smuggling routes to the Assad regime is to limit its supplies to the (Al-Qaterji-SDF) contract, which stipulates the purchase of a quantity of more than one million tons, and according to the available quantity at a price of \$550 per ton. It is worth noting that the Autonomous Administration had approved the price of wheat at 31 cents per kilo, or \$310 per ton, subject to the grading system





Daesh conduct an attack on a militia affiliated with the Revolutionary Guard militia in the, east of Deir Ezzor

Three members of the Mu'ayzila group, affiliated with the tribal militia of the Revolutionary Guard militia, were missing after an attack by unknown persons believed to be from ISIS at midnight last night, according to what a Deir Ezzor 24 network correspondent reported. Our correspondent said that the attack also resulted in the injury of approximately 10 members who were taken to the hospital in the town of Salhiya in the Albukamal countryside, in addition to burning two militia cars. He added that the attack was carried out on motorcycles in the "Valley of Death" area, which extends from the town of Al-Duwair to Abbas Point 5 in the eastern desert of Deir ez-Zor. It is noteworthy that the missing and injured members are all from the Tribal Brigade affiliated with Nawaf al-Bashir, including the leader Khalaf al-Zarzour from the town of Tabiya Jazira and 3 from Khasham.

Who is the leader of the Revolutionary Guard, "Khalaf Al-Zarzour"?

"Khalaf Al-Zarzour" comes from the town of Al-Tabiya, an island in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor. He is 37 years old, married to three women. He joined the Free Army at the beginning of the revolution and moved to SDF-controlled areas, only to return under an Iranian settlement mediated by "Nawaf Al-Bashir" in early 2018. "Al-Zarzour" is considered the field commander of the Tribal Brigade militia, led by "Nawaf Al-Bashir", which is affiliated with the Revolutionary Guard militia. He supervises 11 points in the Maizila area, south of Al-Bukamal, in addition to groups affiliated with the militia in the town of Al-Salhiya in the Al-Bukamal countryside. He receives orders directly from the commander of the Revolutionary Guard militia, called "Hajj Malik," while presenting the spoils to Al-Bashir in the villas of the suburb of Deir Ezzor. Al-Zarzour is known as a professional thief who searched the entire Muayzilah camp, the T2 station, and a number of engineering equipment from the people of the Albukamal area for the benefit of pilgrims from the Revolutionary Guard militia, and Nawaf Al-Bashir, who uses it to collect money, equipment, food rations, stolen goods, livestock, and agricultural products, and to search items for his own benefit. "Al-Zarzour" manages the "Hajj Malik" building and rest house in the Mu'izila area, and employs its military members to work in exchange for weekly vacations, while receiving sums estimated at hundreds of millions of liras for these works. which he shares with Sheikh "Nawaf Al-Bashir."





Iranian militias reject a request to the Assad regime endowment in Al-Bukamal related to mosques


A few days ago, the Assad regime's Endowments Directorate in the city of Albukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, submitted a request to the Friends' Office of the Iranian-backed militias in the city regarding some Al-Bukamal mosques, according to what a DeirEzzor24 network local reporter. Our reporter said that the Endowments' request was to allow it to restore 7 mosques in the city of Al-Bukamal, but the Friends' Office rejected the Endowments Directorate's request to restore the mosques, without explaining the reasons. The Iranian-backed militias impose their control on the city of Albukamal, and even the Assad regime does not have any decision there.





Dozens of drowning cases in Deir Ezzor since summer

The Assad regime's Civil Defense Directorate has recorded 21 drowning cases in areas under its control from Deir Ezzor to date and since the beginning of the summer of this year, according to a DeirEzzor24 network local reporter. Our local reporter said that the number of drowning cases exceeded this number, except for some of them that were not documented as a result of the exhumation of bodies by the people, in addition to drowning cases in SDF-controlled areas on the other bank of the Euphrates River in Deir Ezzor Governorate, so that the number approached 50 drowning cases within one month as a result of the lack of Electricity and high temperatures. The Euphrates River in Deir Ezzor is the first destination for people to swim and relax with the onset of summer, which leads to cases of drowning due to the danger of its waters





The Revolutionary Guard militia transports a weapons depot from Al-Bukamal

The Revolutionary Guards moved the weapons depot located near the Human Resources headquarters in Albukamal to the town of Ayyash, west of Deir Ezzor, a private source told the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that, in the evening, the militia began moving the warehouse using different types of cars to remove suspicion from it, and headed to the town of Ayyash, west of Deir ez-Zor, to relieve the city of Al-Bukamal, as it had become full of weapons coming from Iraq. The town of Ayyash contains the largest weapons depots belonging to the Iranian-backed militias in Deir Ezzor





The Revolutionary Guard militia returns to stealing antiquities in Deir Ezzor

The Revolutionary Guard militia has returned to excavating antiquities in the countryside of the city of Albukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, according to what a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. According to him, the militia returned to excavating archaeological sites through some of the leaders responsible for Al-Bukamal axis and its countryside, including "Haj Saeed, who is considered to be the one carrying out these operations through some local elements, as well as some civilians who work as "guides" in the nearby area. 

Deaths and injuries from Iranian-backed militias in raid in Al-Bukamal countryside

A member of the "Sayyid al-Shuhada" Brigades, affiliated with the "Islamic Resistance" militia, was killed in the bombing that targeted an arms shipment for the militias in the Albukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor, last night, according to pro-militia social media pages. A DeirEzzor24 network local reporter said that two members of the Revolutionary Guard militia were injured in the bombing and were taken to the military hospital in the city of Deir Ezzor, in the presence of someone called Al-Hajj (Dr. Marouf), head of the medical department of the Revolutionary Guard militia. drone targeted a weapons shipment vehicle in the town of Al-Sukariyah in the Al-Bukamal countryside, east of Deir Ezzor Governorate, last night, loaded with missiles and ammunition.





The Revolutionary Guard militia applies strict security measures in Al-Bukamal

The leadership of the Revolutionary Guard militia has issued orders to members protecting the military headquarters in the city of Al-Bukamal and its surroundings to prevent civilians, especially from using cell phones while passing in front of the headquarters, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. ccording to the reporter, the militia leadership authorized the security forces to immediately arrest anyone suspected of using a mobile phone after the warning. The Revolutionary Guard militia's leadership aims to give a heightened security character for fear of the spread of sites and pictures of its new headquarters in the city of Al-Bukamal
