An attempt to assassinate an Iranian commander in Deir Ezzor and accusations are directed toward a regime militia

The Iranian-backed militias mobilized, east of the city of Deir Ezzor, after an attempt to target an Iranian leader, “Hajj,” last night, near the development headquarters in the Harabesh neighborhood, east of the city of Deir Ezzor, according to what a DeirEzzor24 network correspondent reported. Our correspondent said that the assassination attempt was carried out around ten o'clock at night by two young men riding a motorcycle, targeting the Iranian leader's car with a gun while it was parked. He added that the attack failed and the two attackers fled after the shooting. It is noteworthy that Alawite security immediately deployed in the area, and deployed barriers at the entrances to the neighborhood, amid accusations that the National Defense Militia was involved in the operation.

Leaders from the Revolutionary Guard militia met with representatives of the tribal army fighting against the SDF in areas under its control in Deir Ezzor (east of the Euphrates), according to what a private source reported to the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that the meeting was held within the headquarters of the Iranian Security Office in the Al-Jami'at neighborhood, and it was the first meeting held between the militia leadership in Al-Bukamal and the tribal army, as the leaders of the Revolutionary Guard militia in Deir Ezzor and Al-Mayadeen are responsible for the tribal army with training and support. The meeting was attended by members of the revolutionary militia called "Hajj Jahid," the head of the security office, and "Hajj Ismail," the official of recruitment and human resources, and it was agreed to begin opening the door to recruitment for the tribal army in Albukamal and its countryside. It is worth noting that the leaders of the Revolutionary Guard militia in Albukamal agreed with the official commander of the Tribal Army that the Revolutionary Guard militia in Albukamal would train members of the Tribal Army within its camps in Al-Bukamal.



Iranian-backed militias are preparing to begin massive military maneuvers in Al-Bukamal

The leader of the Revolutionary Guard militia, called “Hajj Malik,” held a closed security and military meeting at his headquarters in the Al-Jami’at neighborhood (formerly the home of Hajj Askar), according to what a private source reported to the Deir ez-Zor 24 network. Our correspondent, the source, said that the reason for the meeting was to coordinate military maneuvers in which all military sectors would participate and also include Hezbollah militia and groups of the Popular Mobilization Forces militia present on the outskirts of Albukamal. He added that the maneuvers will include all weapons, and will use live ammunition, mine engineering, and emergency teams, and nearly a thousand members from various Iranian-backed militias will participate. The maneuvers are scheduled to begin in the Maizila area in the Albukamal countryside in the next few days.



The former governor of Deir Ezzor was arrested in the United States of America

International agencies and institutions said, the day before, that the American authorities arrested “Samir Othman Al-Sheikh,” governor and head of the security committee in Deir Ezzor Governorate, in 2011 on charges of committing war crimes. Brigadier General Samir Al-Sheikh is from Idlib Governorate. He left for the United States of America to reunite with his wife, who has been an American citizen for four years. He was arrested by the US Federal Bureau of Investigation two days ago. In addition to his crimes and tasks in other governorates, including heading the Political Security Branch in Damascus, Adra Prison, and the administration of the Zabadani region, “Samir Al-Sheikh,” through his duties in Deir Ezzor, is considered primarily responsible for the Al-Joura and Al-Qusour massacre and the massacre of the cemeteries, and responsible for referring detainees from Deir Ezzor Governorate to the security branches and Saydnaya Prison, in addition to giving Direct orders to kill civilians and demonstrators in July 2011.



Iranian-backed militia members steal the contents of a mosque in Al-Bukamal

The Omar Bin Al-Khattab Mosque in the city of Al-Bukamal was vandalized and ransacked by members of the 47th Regiment militia of the Revolutionary Guard militia, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. According to our reporter, militia members stole batteries, audio devices, and lighting devices, in addition to electrical tools from the mosque. He added that a group of residents saw members of the regiment leaving the mosque, carrying the stolen materials in military vehicles belonging to the militia. It is noteworthy that the Iranian-backed militias worked to change the names of some mosques after the expulsion of Daesh from Deir Ezzor.



The Revolutionary Guard militia transports weapons from several headquarters in Al-Mayadeen

During the past few days, the Revolutionary Guard militia transferred weapons from warehouses in the city of Al-Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a DeirEzzor24 network local reporter. Our reporter said that the transfer of weapons came under orders from the so-called "Hajj Maysar", an official in the Revolutionary Guard militia, from the Al-Mayadeen area, after the majority of these warehouses were uncovered, outside the security squares, and distributed to warehouses located on their outskirts, near civilian homes, to avoid targeting these warehouses. He added that the so-called "Hajj Maysar" ordered the number of their members to be reduced in the headquarters located on Al-Arbaeen Street, the Corniche, and the sheep market, and to search for new headquarters close to civilian homes. The Revolutionary Guard militia had transferred members and leaders of different nationalities from the Haidariyah area, south of the city of Al-Mayadeen, to headquarters located within civilian communities, and others newly established in the vicinity of the city, with the aim of protecting them from air and missile strikes



Hezbollah militia deploys members from Al-Bukamal to the Homs countryside

A private source told the DeirEzzor24 network that the Hezbollah militia began gathering its members in Al-Bukamal, especially those from Homs province. The source added that the militia is preparing to transfer some of them to the western countryside of Homs, to enroll them in military courses to increase readiness due to the tension occurring between Hezbollah and Israel on the Palestinian-Lebanese border. He pointed out that the militia sent the leader in its ranks, nicknamed "Hajj Abu al-Zein," the official in charge of Hezbollah's military courses, from Al-Bukamal to the Homs countryside. It is worth mentioning that the militia will replace its members sent to Homs with members from the city of Hama.



A new shipment of drones arrives for the Revolutionary Guard militia in Al-Bukamal

A shipment of drones arrived to the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia in the city of Al-Bukamal coming from Iraqi territory through the Al-Hari crossing, according to what a private source told the DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that the Iranian-backed militias used civilian Hyundai Inter cargo vehicles for transporting vegetables and fruits in the process of transporting the drones. He added that members of the Lebanese Hezbollah militia, most of whom were of Lebanese nationality, carried the shipment of drones and accompanied them until they reached the Al-Katf and Corniche areas in the city of Al-Bukamal, where the drones were placed in underground warehouses. It is noteworthy that the shoulder and Corniche area contains tunnels and underground warehouses that have been converted into something similar to a military base, under the supervision and protection of members of Iraqi and Iranian nationality.



The Revolutionary Guard militia fails to storm a town in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor

A DeirEzzor24 network correspondent said that a group of special forces affiliated with the Revolutionary Guard militia, at the urging of Alawite security, attempted to storm the town of Al-Duwair on Saturday evening. Our reporter added that the storming attempt came to arrest wanted persons from the town. Still, some residents clashed with the patrol, and opened fire randomly, causing the storming group to withdraw towards Salhiya in Al-Bukamal countryside. Both (Hajj Askar and Hajj Malik) accuse the people of the town of Al-Duwair of harboring militants, facilitating attacks on Iranian points, and cooperating with them in all operations targeting Mu'ayzilah points and the T2 station road, south of the city of Albukamal, east of Deir Ezzor Governorate.



Assad forces and their militias are on alert in Deir Ezzor

The National Defense militia and the Al-Quds Brigade militia have been on alert in the city of Deir Ezzor and its countryside in the past few days, according to a DeirEzzor24 local reporter. Our reporter said that the alert was due to the military campaign launched by Assad's forces, the Iranian militias and their affiliated militias in the areas of Deir ez-Zor and Palmyra. He added that Assad's forces and the militias loyal to them completely banned vacations from the personnel, and forced them to spend the night inside the headquarters. It is worth noting that some members of the National Defense Militia refrained from joining their headquarters, for fear of being transferred to desert points



Hezbollah militia deploys reinforcements from Iraq and Deir Ezzor to Damascus

Several private cars and two buses entered Al-Bukamal yesterday, from Iraq, through Al-Qaim Gate in the Al-Bukamal countryside, according to a DeirEzzor24 network local reporter. Our reporter stated that the buses were loaded with members of the Iraqi Hezbollah militia, wearing civilian camouflage clothing. He added that as soon as the two buses entered Albukamal, they quickly headed to the international road, accompanied by military protection, to meet a third bus loaded with members from Al-Bukamal, and headed to Damascus. The Hezbollah militia sending members to Damascus from Iraq and Deir Ezzor comes within the framework of mobilization and alert as a result of the escalation of military operations in Lebanon.



Dozens of buses carrying Shiite pilgrims leave Al-Bukamal for Iraq

This morning, dozens of buses belonging to Iranian-backed militias left Syrian territory, returning to Iraq, carrying Shiite visitors through Al-Bukamal Al-Qaim border crossing, a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network reported today. Our reporter said that the number of buses exceeded 40, and they came from Damascus after the “visitors” participated in Shiite celebrations, allegedly “visiting the shrines.” The Iranian-backed militias take advantage of the buses of “visitors” coming from Iraq, to pass elements and ammunition inside them, to avoid being targeted
