The Revolutionary Guards Militia Takes Care of the Wounded of the Tribal Army Militia



A reporter of the DeirEzzor24 Network said that the Revolutionary Guards Militia took care of the wounded of the "Tribal Army" Militia led by "Ibrahim Al-Haffel" in Deir Ezzor. The Revolutionary Guards Militia recently announced its responsibility for the medical care of the "Tribal Army" Militia. It put its medical equipment, ambulances, medical points, and hospitals at the service of "Al-Haffel" elements. Notably, the Russian forces summoned the two sheiks "Al-Haffel" and "Al-Bashir" about a month ago and gave them instructions to adhere to in Deir Ezzor Governorate

Details of targeting a weapons truck of the Iranian-backed militias in the countryside of



A drone targeted a closed truck (refrigerator) this afternoon in the town of Al-Sukkariyah in the vicinity of the city of Albukamal, east of Deir Ezzor, according to a reporter of DeirEzzor24 Network. Our reporter said that the truck entered from Iraq through the Syrian-Iraqi border, loaded with weapons for the Iranian-backed militias, followed by the entry of a second truck for camouflage, and the drone was chasing the truck until it left the city of Albukamal and entered the village of Al-Sukkariyah to target it with a missile that destroyed the truck and its cargo, without recording any deaths or injuries. The Iranian security forces imposed a security cordon around the truck, and barriers were set up on the roads leading to the village from both directions, and the truck was towed to the desert so that no one would see it

Deir Ezzor 24 meets a young man from Deir Ezzor who was awarded the "Bravery Medal" by German officials



German officials, headed by the Minister of the Interior of the State of Bayern in the German city of Munich, honored a young man from Deir Ezzor Governorate and awarded him the Bravery Medal, for an act that sums up the good morals that most of the people of Deir Ezzor possess, represented by saving a woman who was being assaulted and beaten by a person in one of the streets of the city of Augsburg, two years ago.

DeirEzzor24 network met the young man "Mohammed" and the following conversation took place: My name is "Mohammed Al-Hassan" from the town of Al-Mari'iyah in the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor. I received the Bravery Medal yesterday in the German state of Bavaria because of a story that happened to me two years ago that I will tell you. "The story took place nearly two years ago, when a friend of mine was driving me home in his car in the evening, and we saw a strange movement in the street, and when we turned the light towards the source of the movement, a terrified woman was heading towards us, and when she got closer to me, I saw her face bloody and her clothes torn, and she had been violently beaten by two people who were chasing her,

then I decided to help her and stand up to the criminals"
He added "When the criminals saw the woman had reached us, they preferred to run away, but I immediately followed them and caught one of them, after he tried to hit me with a sharp object, and at that time my friend was calming the woman down and trying to provide her with first aid and called the police who arrived at the site minutes later, my friend and I testified and the police thanked us and we left" "A few days ago, I received an invitation from officials in the state of Bavaria to honor me, along with 31 other people, with medals of honor, for similar actions they had taken in previous years, and the honor was attended by officials from the state, deputies and the police chief And representatives of the church and legal figures."

He concluded his speech by saying, "I came to Germany 9 years ago, where I studied and worked, and I am now preparing to study civil engineering. I want to say that even if the place has changed, the chivalry and generosity that we were raised on compel us to help the distressed and support the oppressed, regardless of their nationality.

The Revolutionary Guards Militia Stops All Its Wireless Communications in Deir Ezzor



According to a reporter of the DeirEzzor24 Network, the Revolutionary Guards Militia has stopped all wireless communications through wireless broadcasting stations in Al-Bukamal, Al-Mayadeen, and Ayash in Deir Ezzor. According to our reporter, the militia has stopped using wireless communication devices that operate on wireless radio frequencies and ordered military communication between points via landline telephone. This measure comes after the explosions of the "pager" devices in a Hezbollah militia HQ in Lebanon, which caused the death of dozens and the injury of thousands of them.

The Revolutionary Guards militia fortifies its communications networks in Deir Ezzor



The Revolutionary Guards militia in Deir Ezzor city has begun fortifying its communications and signal networks, according to a reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. Our reporter said that the militia changed the special codes used in wireless communications, and brought in a jamming system placed on the radar of the military airport and the signal section near it in the Harabesh neighborhood. The Iranian Security Office issued a decision stipulating that the passwords and frequencies of the communication devices "heaters" be changed daily for fear of being hacked, similar to what happened with the elements of the Hezbollah militia

Lebanese Hezbollah militia suddenly withdraws from headquarters in Deir Ezzor



the Lebanese Hezbollah militia suddenly withdrew from its position in the Rural Development Center and the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering in the Harabesh neighborhood in Deir Ezzor city, according to a reporter of the DeirEzzor24 network. Our reporter said that the Hezbollah militia had turned the Faculty of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering and the Rural Development Center in the Harabesh neighborhood in the center of Deir Ezzor city into headquarters for manufacturing drugs and weapons. He added that the Rural Development Center includes a garage for cars and warehouses for Iranian missiles, while the building of the Faculty of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering consists of 3 floors and a basement, and contains a weapons warehouse, places designated for sleeping elements, administrative offices, and a hall for meetings and seminars.

Commanders of Iranian-backed militias leave Al-Mayadeen for Lebanon



Most of the leaders of the Iranian-backed militias have left the city of Mayadeen, east of Deir Ezzor, over the past two days, for the Qusayr area in the Homs countryside and from there to Lebanon, according to a local reporter of the DeirEzzor24 Network .Our reporter said that among those leaving were the so-called "Hajj Najaf", the official in charge of the Iranian "Al-Shifa" hospital in the city of Mayadeen, and "Hajj Malik", the military commander in the Revolutionary Guard militia, with some leaders remaining in the city to complete some administrative matters, with the possibility of joining them. The departure of the militia leaders from Deir Ezzor for Lebanon comes amid an Israeli military escalation against the Hezbollah militia in southern Lebanon

Iran-backed militias beat the drums of war in Deir Ezzor in support of Hezbollah militia



DeirEzzor24 learned from special sources that the Iranian-backed militias are preparing to attack and target areas where the global coalition and SDF are present in Deir Ezzor. According to the sources, the initial targets are the locations where the coalition and SDF are present opposite Al-Bukamal, Al-Mayadeen, and the eastern countryside of Deir Ezzor, reaching the Conoco field base northeast of Deir Ezzor. The sources confirmed that the orders to target the coalition forces came from Iran, and were conveyed by the leader of the Revolutionary Guard militia called "Hajj Reza" during a meeting with the leaders of the Iranian-backed militias in the farms camp on the outskirts of Al-Mayadeen, and demanded the need to respond immediately and urgently to any attack on the militias on Syrian territory, and also demanded a strong response to the international coalition forces, to be implemented in the coming days. This preparation by the Iranian-backed militias in Deir Ezzor comes in conjunction with attacks launched by Israel on the positions of the Lebanese Hezbollah militia in southern Lebanon.

Details of the air strikes that targeted the Iranian-backed militias in Deir Ezzor



After midnight last night, an unknown aircraft targeted the Syrian-Iragi border with four raids, resulting in deaths among the ranks of the Iranian-backed militias and civilian injuries, according to what was monitored by the reporters of Deir Ezzor 24 Network. Our reporters said that the raids targeted the vicinity of the military gate near the Al-Hari village school in the Albukamal countryside, and a site for the Iraqi Popular Mobilization Forces militia, and resulted in the killing of 3 elements of Iraqi nationality, followed by a full alert by the Revolutionary Guards militia within the city of Albukamal and its surroundings, and the aircraft launched several raids within Iraqi territory near the border. Our correspondent added that the Revolutionary Guards militia launched 3 missiles from the vicinity of the Deir Ezzor military airport towards the international coalition base in the "Conoco Gas Plant", to be responded to directly by the international coalition by launching six missiles targeting the radar battalion on the outskirts of Deir Ezzor airport, and the rural development headquarters in the Harabesh neighborhood affiliated with the Revolutionary Guards militia, resulting in the killing of no less than 5 elements, 4 of whom were recovered from their bodies.

Military leaders from the Hezbollah militia arrive in Deir Ezzor



Four military leaders from the Lebanese Hezbollah militia arrived at Deir Ezzor military airport yesterday by helicopter from the Shayrat airport in Homs province, according to a special source for DeirEzzor24 network. The source said that the military figures headed directly to one of the Iranian on Al-Arbaeen Street headquarters city of in the Al-Mayadeen, which was equipped by the Iranian Revolutionary Guard militia a few days ago, and the so-called "Hajj Hussein", the official of the Revolutionary Guard militia in Al-Mayadeen, was waiting for them. The Revolutionary Guard militia equipped the headquarters and placed a small, unknown device on top of the headquarters, a device that the Lebanese Hezbollah militia has placed on top of all its headquarters.
